- **PEO** launching mandatory CPD starting January 1, 2023
- log in to portal account
- practice status viewable in the account
- select the “PEAK” menu to start.

“Practising”

A licence holder who is an engineering – lecturer who delivers – or who supervises students and research assistants who deliver – contract work or research for parties outside the educational institution, provide expert opinions, provide consulting services, or carry out any other type of paid or volunteer work the involves the activities identified in the definition of the practice of professional engineering

“Not Practising”

An engineering lecturer who only teaches, supervises student projects or carries out basic research with an outcome that would not be directly used or relied upon by others.
