- a) prior to the payment of a deferred pension; or
- where the member continues in his or her employment after the normal b) retirement date, prior to the commencement of payment of pension benefits

then the person who is the spouse of the member or former member at the date of his or her death is entitled to receive a pre-retirement death benefit of either a lump sum payment or an immediate or deferred life annuity from the University of Waterloo Pension Plan, at the date of the member or former member's death.

We understand that we may waive the right of the spouse to receive any pre-retirement death benefit, in which case payment of a lump sum benefit will be made to either.

- a beneficiary designated by the member or former member; or a)
- the personal representative of the member or former member for distribution as b) part of his or her estate.
