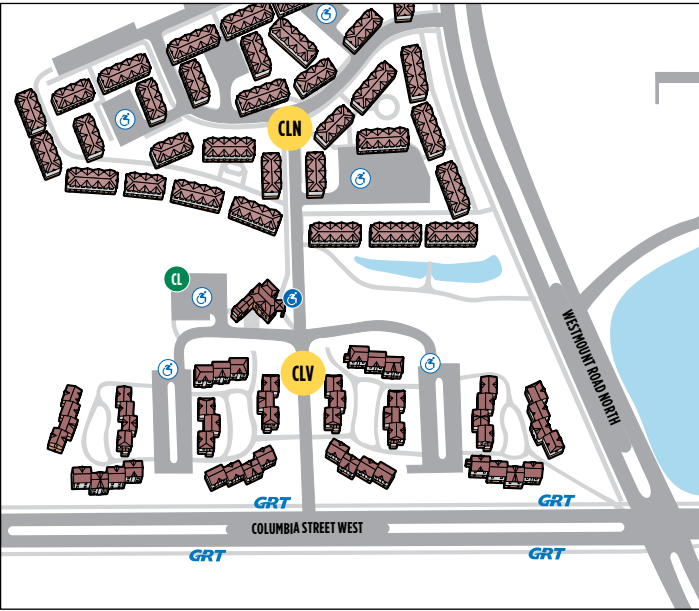
DANA PORTER LIBRARY (LIB)

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (EIT)

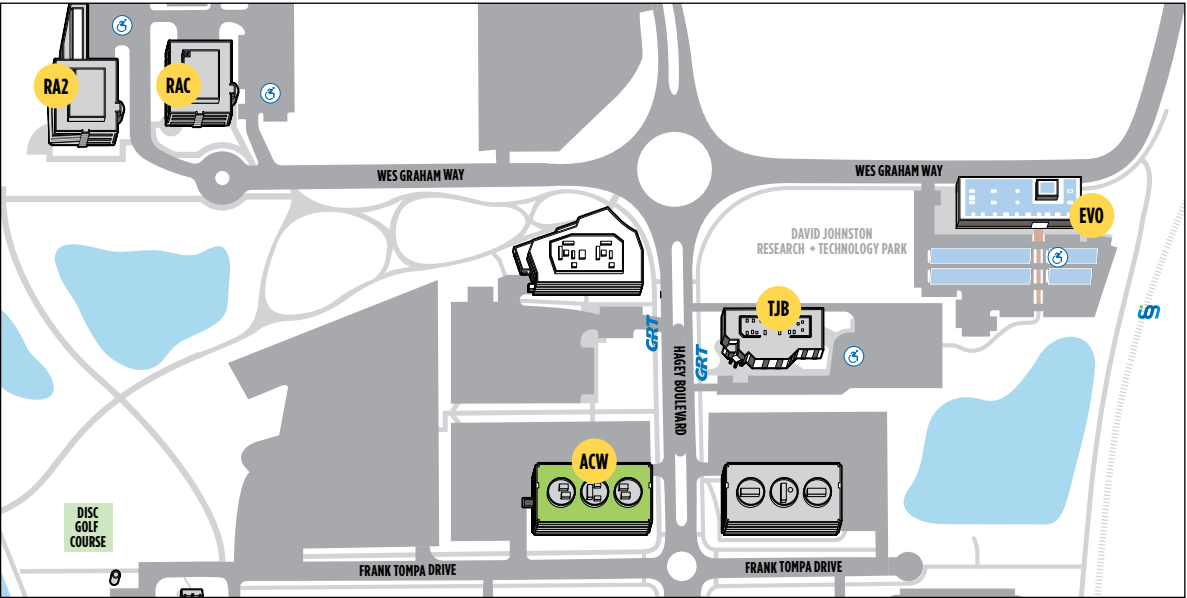
