Faculty of Health Expansion (EXP)

This four-storey facility includes Kinesiology research, student teaching labs and student study space. It's home to the School of Anatomy, one of only a few anatomy labs outside of a medical school in Ontario.

Mathematics 3 (M3)

M3 is the newest of three math buildings on campus. The Bruce White atrium in M3 was named by alum John Hele (BMath '80), in honour of his math teacher from Windsor, Ontario.

Engineering 5 (E5)

Engineering 5 joins a cluster of three buildings, including Engineering 6 and 7. While inside the building, check out the Sedra Student Design Centre, a state-of-the-art 20,000 square-foot space dedicated to student teams. The design centre is named after former Dean of Engineering, Adel Sedra.



Affiliated and Federated Institutions

Across the creek, you'll find the Affiliated and Federated Institutions of Waterloo: Conrad Grebel University College (CGR), United College (UTD), St. Jerome's University (SJU) and Renison University College (REN).

Environment 3 (EV3)

Environment 3 includes a two-storey living air filtration wall. It is the first LEED Platinum certified building on an Ontario university campus.

Hagey Hall (HH) Hub

The Hagey Hall Hub is the newest Arts expansion. The Hub's main floor is named Founders Hall, in honour of the visionaries who founded the University. Founders Hall offers much-needed study spaces and social areas for students in the Faculty of Arts.

William H. Tatham Centre for Co-operative Education and Career Action (TC)

The Tatham Centre hosts thousands of co-op interviews each term. Career advisors in this building can help Waterloo alumni identify their skills and prepare for future careers. The Tatham Centre is named after Waterloo alum and generous donor, Bill Tatham (BASc '83, DEng '12).

Dana Porter Library (LIB)

Located at the heart of campus, Dana Porter is our largest library and an iconic landmark. It was originally built with three stories, but the need for expansion became apparent. The six additional stories were completed in 1970.





Science Teaching Complex (STC)

STC is Science's newest building, designed to be the hub of undergraduate activity for the faculty. It includes student study spaces, social gathering spots, large lecture halls and state-of-the-art labs – all dedicated to first-year students.



Mike & Ophelia Lazaridis Quantum-Nano Centre (QNC)

QNC is home to the largest undergraduate nanotechnology engineering program in Canada and a world-leading quantum institute. The research here will transform technology and benefit society in countless ways. The building was named in honour of Mike and Ophelia Lazaridis' generous support to Waterloo.



Student Life Centre (SLC) and Physical Activities Complex (PAC)

The SLC and PAC are the heart of student life on campus. In September 2021, Waterloo unveiled a 65,000 square-foot expansion to these buildings, providing new recreation and study areas, multi-faith spaces, a climbing wall and more.




Columbia Icefields (CIF)


Located on the north campus, the CIF is a multi-purpose athletic facility with three gyms, an arena, studio fitness centre and meeting spaces. The Feridun Hamdullahpur Field House, opened in 2020 and renamed in 2021, features a multi-activity turf space available to varsity athletes, student groups and the community.


