



Application for an Iris Yuzdepski Memorial Graduate Award

The Iris Yuzdepski Memorial Graduate Award is made possible by a very generous donation from the late Ian Williams in honour and memory of his partner in life Iris Yuzdepski, who achieved her BA with a Major in Anthropology from the University of Waterloo in May, 1971.

The main conditions of the Iris Yuzdepski Memorial Graduate Award are as follows:

- awards will be provided each year to full-time graduate students registered in the second term of their Master's program in the Department of Anthropology in the Faculty of Arts
- the awards are valued at up to \$2,500 each
- selection will be based on academic excellence (min. 80% overall average of current program) and financial need
- applications are to be submitted to the department in February annually
- the awards will be paid annually in the Winter term

For the purposes of this award, the Department of Anthropology considers "financial need" to include both expenses necessary to conduct your planned research, and your personal finances. The applications of applicants who do not receive an Iris Yuzdepski Memorial Graduate Award, either because they do not meet the eligibility requirements or because all available awards have already been distributed, will automatically be considered for funding (for research expenses only) from the Anthropology Department endowment fund if monies are available, which is not guaranteed.
