#### Architecture Electives

The Architecture Elective requirement gives students breadth of study and opportunities for research at the upper levels of the pre-professional program in relation to four curricular areas: Cultural History and Theory (ARCH 540), Technology and Environment (ARCH 570), Visual and Digital Media (ARCH 510), and Urbanism and Landscape (ARCH 520). Three electives, one from each of three of these four thematic areas and course elective streams, must be selected to satisfy the Architecture Elective requirement. These courses can be taken in any term in the third and fourth years (3A, 3B, 4A, 4B) of the BAS program.

#### Open Electives

The Open Elective requirement gives students some breadth of studies related to their role as educated professionals in society. Three electives from any disciplines, must be completed to satisfy the Architecture Open Elective requirement. These courses can be taken in any term in the third and fourth years (3A, 3B, 4A, 4B) of the BAS program.
