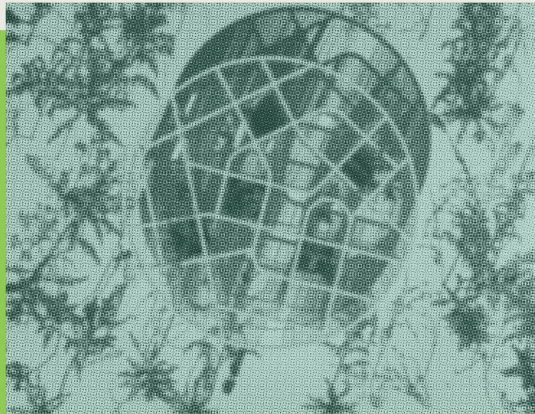

Teresa Gali-Izard is an Associate Professor at the University of Virginia School of Architecture principal of ARQUITECTURA AGRONOMIA, a landscape architecture firm located in Barcelona. In the last 20 years she has been involved in some of the most important contemporary landscape architecture projects in Europe including TMB Park, Coastal Park, new urbanization Passeig de Sant Joan in Barcelona and the Sant Joan Landfill restoration, which won the European Urban Public Space award in 2004. Gali-Izard is the author of "The Same Landscapes. Ideas and interpretations", published by Gustavo Gili in 2005.
