Arch 684 Roma Tre Workshop March 2010

The collaboration between mixed teams of Roma Tre and Waterloo Masters Students will examine a recent piece of redundant Roman infrastructure, namely the Tangenziale or Tiburtina Highway constructed in the 1960's to link major traffic routes across an enormous rail corridor.
