Society/club name: Accounting and Finance Orientation Week (AFOW)

Reason for subsidy:

The University of Waterloo's annual Accounting and Finance Orientation Week (AFOW) welcomes some of the brightest first year students across various Faculties, including the Faculty of Arts. Throughout the week, these students actively engage in exciting and educational events, where they forge deeper connections in the accounting and finance community. However, these events are highly costly - especially with the rapidly increasing participation rate every year. Furthermore, revenue is a variable factor for us as it is dependent on the per student fee while expenses are mainly fixed. AFOW has been rigorously trying to cut costs due to our lack of funds and this is getting to the point where it will start impacting the quality of our events. We do not want to have to do that in the future and we wish to deliver better quality events for incoming students and give them a good impression of the University of Waterloo. We hope that ASU gives us the chance to improve the quality of our events, make them bigger and better and respond to student feedback over the years, such as "our venue for the semi-formal isn't large enough", "not enough food was provided during the events", etc. We also hope to create strong and lasting impressions of SAF, the University of Waterloo and supportive organizations, such as ASU, in the community. In order to do so, the AFOW team asks for your generous contribution and support for our events.

Appendix B: German Studies Society Grant Proposal

Organization: Society

Society/club name: UW German Society

Reason for subsidy:

Bratwurst Cookout day. Bratwurst is a traditional German sausage made from pork and veal, which is barbequed, or pan roasted. We would be applying to use ASU grills for a cookout with our society for students. In the prior terms we have sold Bratwurst to students, but we would like to offer an event without charging students for bratwursts. Currently we lack the funds to organize this event and offer it to students pro bono. We hope this grant application to fund the event will provide us the opportunity for free events.

Location (if applicable): In front of Modern Language Building in Arts Courtyard

Number of participants: 5 (running the event)

Total expenditures:

\$85.00 Buns \$250.00 Bratwurst

\$50.00 Sauerkraut, Curry wurst sauce, ketchup, mustard

\$15.00 Cutlery, napkins

TOTAL Estimated Cost: \$400.00

Expected revenues:

If we charge for Bratwurst \$2-3 dollars then we can make ~\$400.00-500.00 dollars, in which we would ask \$200.00 to help cover initial expenditure. If we wish to make it free to students (which we do), then we ask ASU to cover at least \$300 dollars.

Loan or grant: Grant

Proposed subsidy from Arts Student Union:

Either \$200.00 for ASU to cover a cost-reduced event with Bratwurst for sale at ~\$3.00 or less per bratwurst. OR, \$300.00-400.00 to cover the event pro bono so arts students can have free bratwurst.

Allotment already received this term: Receiving \$200.00 from ASU in funding this term.
