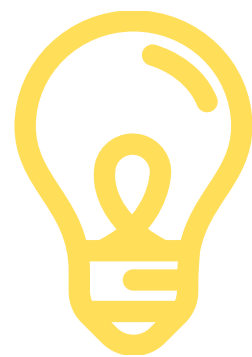

Eligibility

WHO CAN JOIN?

- Registered as a graduate student at UW with at least one year left before graduation
- Supervised by a UW researcher in the biomedical field
- Must be able to commit to a minimum of 7 hours of training per term, and complete 7 hours in each module in order to receive a CREATE certificate
