## Biomedical Engineering Graduate Program MASc Thesis Proposal Form

Students should work with their supervisor(s) to establish a MASc Advisory Committee.

The MASc Advisory Committee must include at least three examiners (four in the case of co-supervision):

- The student's supervisor or co-supervisors (one is to be a tenured or tenure track BME graduate faculty member)
- One tenured or tenure track BME graduate faculty member (the internal)
- One additional examiner who is not a BME graduate faculty member but still a member of the University of Waterloo (the internal/external)
- A maximum of one committee member can have an adjunct appointment or emeritus status
