## **Advisory Committee Guidelines**

Students should work with their supervisor to establish an Advisory Committee.

The committee must include at least four examiners (five in the case of co-supervision):

- The student's supervisor or co-supervisors
- Two tenured or tenure-track faculty members that are BME graduate faculty members (the internals)
- One tenured or tenure-track faculty member that is not a BME graduate faculty member but still a member of the University of Waterloo (the internal/external)
- No more than 1 adjunct faculty member may serve on the committee
- Of the three additional committee members beyond the student's supervisor(s), at least two must hold regular faculty appointments at the University of Waterloo
