Artists-in-Residence Hannah Gardiner and Jakob Michael Stephan are collecting previously untranslated German language poems to be included in a bilingual collection of German Mennonite poetry from the Waterloo Region. The project's goal is to maintain dialogue across generations within the local Mennonite literary tradition by translating these works.

Poems must be written by a Mennonite author from or connected to Waterloo Region from any time period. Works written in German or Pennsylvania Dutch are both encouraged.

The project culminates with a public reading in Spring of 2023.
