# Gampus Housing






Supporting over 200 residents from all six faculties, Renison is one of the closest residences to your classes at Waterloo.


Renison's close-knit residence community is known for prioritizing inclusivity, belonging, and a vibrant student experience. As a Renison resident, you'll benefit from:

- Access to on-campus events and off-campus excursions





## Suite-style

Apartment with access to a kitchen to cook your meals

Fees include total housing fees for eight months, with or without optional meal plan. Lowest end of the range does not include a meal plan. Students without a meal plan should add \$3,000-\$5,000 (\$375-\$625/month) for groceries and dining out.

Fees include total housing fees for eight months, mandatory meal plan included. Students can choose one of three tiers for Campus Housing meal plans. Renison, St. Jerome's, and United meal plans are all-inclusive.




