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## Wellbeing in Bruce and Grey Counties: <br> A Summary of Results <br> from the CIW Community Wellbeing Survey

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## What is Wellbeing?

There are many definitions of wellbeing. The Canadian Index of Wellbeing has adopted the following as its working definition:

The presence of the highest possible quality of life in its full breadth of expression focused on but not necessarily exclusive to: good living standards, robust health, a sustainable environment, vital communities, an educated populace, balanced time use, high levels of democratic participation, and access to and participation in leisure and culture.

## Introduction

The Bruce and Grey Counties Community Wellbeing Survey was launched in the spring of 2018 when invitations to participate were mailed to 17,375 randomly selected households. In total, the number of invitations was equal to approximately $25 \%$ of all households in the two Counties, divided proportionally across the principal municipalities to ensure complete and representative coverage. The selection of households also included an oversampling of the smaller rural areas within the Counties to ensure adequate representation of residents living in smaller communities. One person in each household, aged 16 years or older, was invited to complete the questionnaire.

The survey was closed at the end of June, 2018. Of the 1,759 usable questionnaires that were returned, most were completed online ( $91.2 \% ; n=1,605$ ) with the remaining surveys ( $8.8 \% ; n$ $=154$ ) were completed using a paper version that could be specially requested by residents who preferred this latter format. Of the total 1,896 questionnaires returned, 57 were deemed unusable due principally to significant proportions of the questionnaire not having been completed. Therefore, the final, total number of usable questionnaires was 1,759. Taking into account the estimated $2.5 \%$ of household addresses to which invitations could not be delivered (e.g., unoccupied, failure to deliver), the final response rate is estimated to be $10.4 \%$, which corresponds to the response rate of most general population surveys.

This report is comprised mainly of summary, descriptive statistics. It provides frequency distributions and measures of central tendency for all questions across the eight domains comprising the Canadian Index of Wellbeing (CIW) conceptual framework: Community Vitality, Democratic Engagement, Education, Environment, Healthy Populations, Leisure and Culture, Living Standards, and Time Use. A demographic profile of residents is presented first and measures of overall wellbeing are reported to conclude the main body of the report.

Accompanying this report, under separate cover, is An Addendum to the Bruce and Grey Counties Community Wellbeing Survey with the unedited comments of survey participants. The comments have been organised by theme and sub-theme to capture the dominant foci represented in the residents' comments. Taken together, the results presented here and in the Addendum provide a snapshot of the overall wellbeing of the residents of the two Counties.

## Weighting of data

In order to ensure the results from the survey are representative of the residents of Bruce and Grey Counties, the data provided by the 1,759 respondents were weighted by sex, age grouping, and municipality to match the 2016 Census profile and population projections ( $N=$ 144,503 ) for those residents 16 years of age and older. Weighting the data allows the overall results presented in this report to more accurately reflect the responses of residents without under- or over-representing any groups based on age, sex, or where they live in Bruce and Grey Counties.

The following tables provide a description of survey participants. Each table first presents the unweighted results for age, sex, and County, and then presents the results for these three characteristics once survey weights are applied. Survey weights are based on the results taken
from 2016 Census of Canada thereby adjusting the distributions of representative respondents to the survey to match the distributions of all residents in the Counties.

To weight the data, participants were assigned to one of the two Counties - Bruce or Grey based on information provided in the survey. Survey results based on both unweighted and weighted data are presented in the following tables: sex (see Table 1), age group (see Table 2), and County (see Table 3).

More specifically, Tables 1 and 2 compare the sample results to the actual distribution for the total population separately for sex and age. The final weighting of the sample incorporated age, sex, and County concurrently to generate the weighted sample, which reflects the overall population distribution across Bruce and Grey Counties (see Table 3).

Women routinely respond to surveys more frequently than men. In Bruce and Grey Counties, women did respond more than men, but less so than expected given the higher proportion of women within the total population. Following weighting based on sex, the numbers adjusted to better reflect the actual distribution of men and women in the two Counties (see Table 1).

People in their middle and later years are more likely to respond to surveys than other age groups, and this was reflected in the results for Bruce and Grey Counties. Many more people aged 55 to 74 years and many fewer individuals under 34 years of age responded to the survey. However, the overall number of responses allowed for the weighting of responses to better reflect the age distribution in the Counties (see Table 2).

[^0]Overall, slightly more responses were received from Bruce County than from Grey County than expected given their overall populations. After weighting by County, the distributions ensured that the results more accurately the voices of the residents regardless of where they live in Bruce and Grey Counties (see Table 3).

## Reading the report

As noted, the results presented in the tables comprising the rest of this report are weighted to reflect estimates for the population of Bruce and Grey Counties, aged 16 years and older. In some cases, the total number of responses does not equal the total population due to missing responses. Non-response typically represents only a few people, so the totals are not substantially less than the population total for the region. In other instances, people might simply have chosen not to answer specific questions for a variety of reasons (e.g., felt the question was irrelevant to them, did not recall the requested information, or thought the question was too personal). For example, many people often choose not to answer questions about income; in this survey, $16.3 \%$ of the residents declined to report their incomes, which is fairly typical. For some questions, response categories of "does not apply" or "don't know" were provided, and these answers are not reported in the tables. Again, these responses typically are used by only a few people. Finally, total percentages in a few tables may not add up to exactly $100 \%$ due to rounding.

All of the tables present the results for Bruce and Grey Counties separately and then for the entire Region overall.

Table numbers linked to titles correspond with survey question numbers (e.g., Table J3 for age of respondent refers to question $\mathbf{J} 3$ on the questionnaire). For tables listing several items for which residents have reported participation or have rated on scales such as level of agreement or perceptions, there are separate tables for each item in the scale. For example, Table A7 in the Community Vitality section concerning perceptions of sense of their community as a place to live, there are 12 tables comparing responses by municipality listed as Tables A7a to A7k. For questions that ask participants to indicate their level of agreement or satisfaction with a statement, the levels have been collapsed into more meaningful categories for ease of interpretation. For example, when measuring level of agreement along a 7-point scale where 1 $=$ strongly disagree and $7=$ strongly agree, the first three values ( 1,2 , and 3 ) have been categorised as disagree, a value of 4 is neutral, and the last three values ( 5,6 and 7 ) are categorised as agree.

Finally, not all response categories are reported for some of the open-ended demographic questions, especially when the number of responses is very low. In these instances, explanatory text follows the table in footnotes.
