Job Postings

Jobs posted daily, as they are received

Recruitment

• Typically occurs in the **Fall** and **Winter** terms. Some Capital Markets/Finance employers begin recruiting in **Spring** term

Applications

- Employers will specify which documents must be submitted with application
- Application deadlines will vary and will be noted on the posting
- Most employers will ask that you apply direct via their external website

Interviews

- Most employers contact directly via email/phone to schedule interviews, but some will use WaterlooWorks (you will be notified if so)
- Interviews for Winter 2024 (if booked on WaterlooWorks) may take place virtually or in-person

Hire via job ad or résumé


Hire someone referred by trusted colleague, friend or agency
