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ARRANGING YOUR OWN JOB (AOJ)

Steps to arrange your own job for co-op credit

Search on external job sites, [JADA](#), through your personal connections, or attend a Career Fair (September 23: [P4E Job Fair](#))



Once you accept a job offer, submit an Arrange Own Job (AOJ) form on WaterlooWorks within 7 days of accepting the role

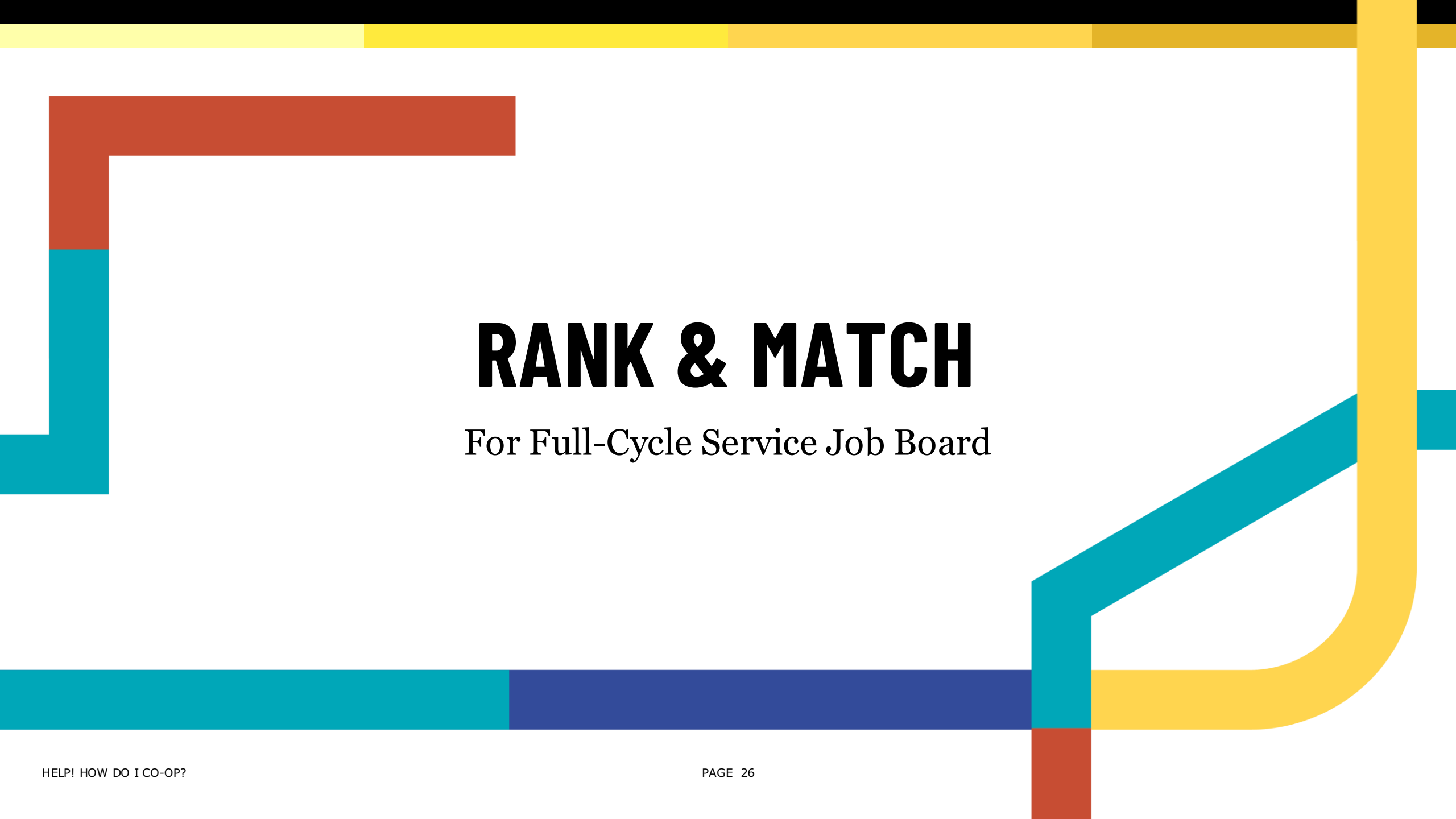


A co-op staff will be in touch if we require more info to approve your job for co-op credit

Chat with your co-op advisor to learn more about:

- If a job that you are interested in is likely to receive a co-op credit (i.e. Standard Work Term)
- How to provide an employer more information about co-op (i.e. fundings/tax credits available)

RANK & MATCH

For Full-Cycle Service Job Board

RANKING: PROCESS

How does the ranking process work?

- After interviews are over for each cycle, employers rank students from 1-10 and *then* the students rank the jobs/employer from 1-10 in return; employers cannot see your rankings.
- After the employers submit their rankings, you can view and submit/save your own rankings on the dates and times specified on the important dates calendar.
- The system adds together scores and picks lowest sum for each job to make matches

(Employers rank students 1-10)
+ (Students rank employers 1-10)

= Algorithm selects lowest sum
to result in a match

RANKING: REMINDERS

- You must submit rankings for every job on your ranking form before the deadline closes. If you do not submit your rankings on time, the system will automatically rank every job a “10”.
- If you rank the job a **10**, it's still **possible that you'll be matched**. Think about this possibility when you are applying!
- You can submit up to **10** "[Not Interested](#)" rankings per term to **guarantee** that you will **not** be matched with a job and/or prioritize other jobs of interest!
- Concerns about the job – connect with your co-op advisor immediately following an interview – don't wait until the day of the ranking.
- Rank carefully! If you are matched with a job, it means you have accepted the position. Failing to proceed with this commitment as per the coop terms and conditions will result in [renege consequences](#).

WHAT IF I DON'T FIND A JOB?

OPTIONS AND CONSIDERATIONS:

- Stay active in the job search until the last possible date for co-op credit!
Many students find employment after work term has begun.
 - **February 16:** Last day to start work to earn a [standard co-op credit](#) for the winter 2027 work term
 - **March 15:** Last day to start work to earn a [flexible co-op credit](#) for the winter 2027 work term
- Explore [WEAccelerate](#): Opt-in program (for UG +1st WT) to gain flexible co-op credit & gain industry experience
- Minimum degree requirements = sequence buffer (you can typically miss 1 work term)
- How can you enhance your transferable skills?
 - Part time job, volunteer, take a course, explore other options to [develop your skills](#), etc.
- Work with us before you panic!

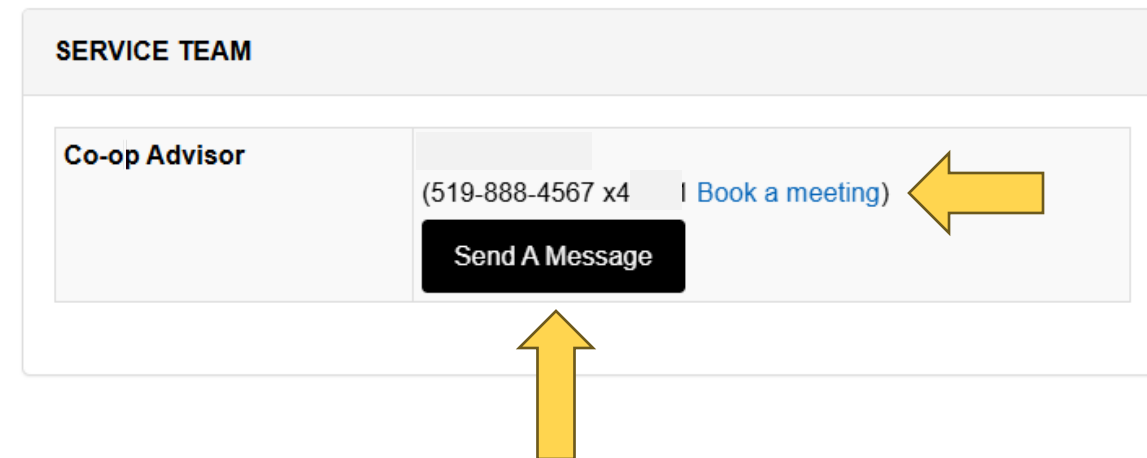

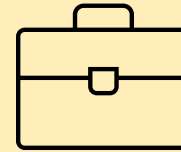
