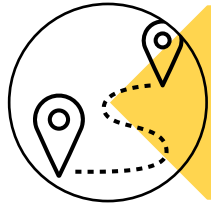

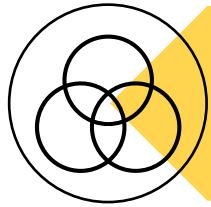
What is the purpose of this genre of writing?

- A chance for you to say things in human words

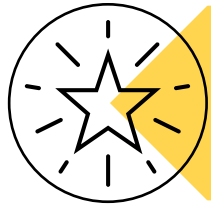
