

Process required...



- → Learning PebblePad
- → Creating content, structure, interactions, visuals
- → Overall checks and feedback

- Key: Integrates all the attributes I needed (and more)

Instructor/Administrator

Tracking submissions

- Assignments, rubrics, evaluation in one place
- Personalized feedback
- Admin collaboration
- LEARN integration



Student user • In addition to what was shared

- Access to recorded feedback
- Ability to personalize projects
- Students can take their portfolio when they graduate



Challenges • Learning curve

- Have a structure from the beginning → not for brainstorming
- Some functions may be in different places
- No autosave
- Detailed instructions required
