

2010 Scholarship of Teaching and Learning: You're Already Doing It! A Research Conference on Teaching and Learning

Many post-secondary educators who are thinking about doing research on teaching and learning are dissuaded from doing so by the perceived extra work such research would entail. However, Dr. Wehlburg argues that this perception is misguided. If teaching, learning and student assessment are happening in your classroom (and they are!), then you've already done most of the work needed to be a scholar of teaching and learning. This engaging and interactive workshop will help participants develop the strategies they need to parlay course prep and assessment time into powerful "scholarship of teaching and learning" results.
