The vision of Peace for All Canada is to build united and prosperous communities, living peacefully side by side. Challenge Statement

Marginalized people and people with drug addictions in Kitchener-Waterloo lack access to suitable supports as they navigate the legal system. There are other groups of the population who are also experiencing significant challenges in resolving their legal problems with the traditional model of legal services.

Impact on the Organization

Peace For All Canada is developing the Community Legal Information Project to help vulnerable groups in Kitchener-Waterloo. We want to connect people from the marginalized communities and also people with low income with suitable legal resources. The project will rely on peer-to-peer training by people with lived experience.

Potential Connections

Anticipated project partners include St. John's Kitchen, The Better Tent City, and Supportive Housing Waterloo, as well as trained community members who include former lawyers and judges from four countries (Eritrea, Ukraine, Brazil, and Honduras).

There is also significant support for the idea from a local law firm, police officers, university professors, local members of Parliament and Provincial Parliament, a service club, and others.
