A Residence Drop-in Tutoring Exam Prep Tutor will assist with CHEM 120/120L/123/123L term tests and/or final exam tutoring sessions located in Ron Edyt Village (REV). Exam prep tutors will typically work up to a *maximum* of 54 hours per term, however, there is no guarantee of the actual number of awarded tutoring hours. Note that you are *not required* to work any specific number of hours per term.

A Residence Drop-in Tutoring Weekly Tutor will assist with CHEM 120/120L/123/123L weekly drop-in tutoring sessions located in Village 1 (V1).
