

Quick Start Instructions

Animal Upon Animal (1-4 players)

How to play:

1. Place the green crocodile on a flat surface in the center of all players. It is the base for your animal stack! Give each player one of each of the seven different animals. Any animals left over can be left in the game box.

2. The first player rolls the die. What did you roll?

- **One dot?** Using only one hand, take one of your animals and carefully stack in on the crocodile.
- **Two dots?** One after another, place two different animals on the stack using only one hand.
- The **crocodile**? Take one of your animals and put it next to the mouth or the tail of the crocodile so that both animals touch, like the yellow monkey in the picture. This now gives you more room to stack!
 - If you already have animals on both sides of the crocodile, put an animal beside one of the animals that is already touching the crocodile.
- The **hand**? Give one of your animals to another player. They now have to place it on the animal stack!
- The **question mark**? The other players get to decide together what animal you will have to stack.



3. Did any animals fall down while you were stacking them?! If one falls, place it in your pile. If two or more fell, place two in your pile, and put the rest back in the box.
4. Whoever is first to have no animals left in their pile, wins!
