

Quick Start Instructions

Go Fish Yuk! (2-6 players)

How to play:

1. Give each player **5 cards** face-down. Put the rest in a draw pile in the middle.
2. Take turns looking at your cards and asking any one other player if they have any cards of any **specific food** (e.g., pizza). **You can only ask for cards if you already have one of those cards.**
 - If the player being asked **has** any of these cards (e.g., pizza), they must give them **all** to the asker, and the asker can take another turn.
 - If the player being asked has a **Yuk! card** for a food asked for (e.g., **rotting pizza**) card (for example, cheese) they say **“Yuk!”** and the **asker** has to give them **all** their pizza cards instead of taking them!
 - If the player being asked **doesn't have** any of that card, they tell the asker to **“Go fish!”**. The asker then takes a card from the **draw pile**. If the card drawn by the asker is the **same food** that they asked for, they must show it to all the other players and can then add it to their hand and take another turn. If the card drawn by the asker is not the same food that they asked for, their turn ends.
3. Once a player gets **4 cards of a kind of food**, they must put that pile of cards out face-up in front of them. The corresponding Yuk! card is also discarded by whichever player holds it.
4. The game ends when a player has no cards left in their hand or the draw pile in the middle runs out. Whoever collected the most sets of 4 cards wins!
