

Quick Start Instructions

Indigenous Art Dominoes (2-6 players)

How to play:

1. Place all of the dominoes face down and mix them up. If you are 2 players, take 7 dominoes each. If you are 3 or more players, take 5 each.

Stack the remaining dominoes face down in a pile.

2. Choose a player to go first. This player places one of their dominoes face up on the table.
3. The next player looks to see if they have a domino that has an end that matches the illustration, colour and number of either end side of the domino already there. If they do, they can add it at that end. If they don't have a matching domino, not, they must take a domino from the pile and that ends their turn.
4. As you play further, dominoes can only be added to the two ends of the line. Continue taking turns until someone uses all of their dominoes and wins! If no players can put down a domino or take one from the pile, then the game ends and the player with the fewest dominoes left wins!
