

Quick Tips (use along with the original instructions)

Love Letter (2-6 players)

Setup:

- Give each player a **reference card** that lists the different character types and their actions. (Note that the original instructions provide more detail about actions.)
- Shuffle the **21 character cards** to create the deck. Place the **13 red favor tokens** near the deck.
- Take the top card of the deck and **set it aside face down**. (If there are only 2 players, **draw 3** cards and set them aside **face up**.)
- Deal each player **1 card** from the deck.

How to Play Each Round:

- On each turn, every player will draw 1 card from the deck.
- Choose and play 1 of your 2 cards! Each character has an action that you'll need to deal with immediately after discarding the card **face up in front of you** for everyone to see! (Note: there is no common discard pile.)
- Some character cards may remove other players from the current round!
 - The removed player **places their card face up in front of them**.
 - If this happens, the action on the discarded card cannot be carried out.
 - Don't worry! This is only one round, and you will be back in next round!

Round End and Receiving Red Favor Tokens:

- Continue taking turns until **one** of the 2 events that **end a round** occur:
 1. **The deck runs out.**
 - Any players remaining when this occurs show and compare their character cards. The player with the highest value wins the round!
 - If there's a tie, both players win.
 2. **When only 1 player is left** in the round, they win!
- The player(s) who won the round gain **1 red favor token**.
- To start a new round, repeat the steps above and the **player who won the previous round** goes first.

Game End and Scoring:

- The game ends when a player has **enough favor tokens** to win. Multiple players can win the game if there is a tie!
- **How many tokens (T) are needed to win depends on the number of players:**
2 players = 6T 3 players = 5T 4 players = 4T 5 or 6 players = 3T
