

Quick Start Instructions

Taiga (2-6 players)

How to play:

1. Place the 10 round wooden discs in a circle in the middle of all players. Make sure that no four disks show the same animal by flipping it over or reshuffling. Place the cards in a pile, face down, to the side of the circle. Give 6 little round tokens to each player and put the rest away.
2. Flip the top card from the pile, and place face-up in the middle of the circle. This is the animal you want to find 4 of in this round.
3. The first player begins by flipping a disk:
 - If the flip shows a **different** animal, the player **puts** one of their tokens in the middle of the circle. It is now the next players turn!
 - If the flip shows the **same** animal as the card, the player gets to **take** a token from the middle of the circle and play again. If there are no tokens in the circle, they can steal one from another player.
4. The player who flips the fourth and final animal of the family wins **any tokens that in the middle of the circle as well as the card**. Time for the next round!
5. To start a new round, draw a new card. If all four of the new animal are already visible, place that card at the bottom of the deck and draw a new card.
6. Players now take turns again flipping over disks as in steps 2 and 3 and rounds continue until all the cards are gone.
7. Time to count points! **Tokens = 1** point and **cards = 2** points. The player with the most points wins!
