


Surface Hub Start Screen Menu: On the Surface Hub start screen you will be able to see several items:

- 1. Clock with Date & Time
- 2. One Button Click to Join a booked meeting
- 3. The call button to start a new Teams Call
- 4. The Whiteboard button to jump to whiteboard
- 5. The Connect button to project your screen from another device
- 6. The sign in button to sign into you account and access your files and calendar

On the surface Hub Start Screen, at the very bottom in the center you will see the Start Button.

Clicking the Start Button will automatically launch you to the start menu on the Surface Hub









Under Home, you will be able to see the Hub meetings booked, you Teams button, whiteboard button, and connect button.

You will also see all you pinned apps on the Surface Hub (default apps shown in image)




Under All Apps is where you will find all installed programs on your Hub



By clicking on the End Session button, the Hub will offer to sign you out of all apps and start fresh for the next user


Under My Meetings and Files, you can sign into the Hub with your account to access your recent files from OneDrive, you calendar from Outlook, and this will sign you into the Office apps and office.com as well to access you full M365 apps








Starting a Teams meeting on the Hub: To start a meeting on the hub click the Call button on the Home screen. This will launch Whiteboard and Teams on the and you can start your meeting by clicking Meet Now.

During a Teams Call on the Hub, there are 3 option on the bottom right you can use:

- 1. Full Screen Mode
- 2. Add Participants
- 3. Teams Settings



In a Teams call on the Hub, you have a call control bar with some options that can be used in the call:

- 1. Camera
- 2. Microphone
- 3. Share Screen
- 4. More features
- 5. Teams Whiteboard




You can project your device on the Hub and share you screen with those in the same room by pressing:

Click on the Whiteboard icon on the Hub home screen will launch Microsoft Whiteboard



You'll be able to utilize the Whiteboard tools for your meetings in person or on a Teams call. Various markers, tools, the ability to insert files and pictures, plus more are at your disposal







Once you are logged on to your Surface Hub, 3 key buttons can be found on the bottom center:

- **The Start Button** 1.
- **Task View** 2.
- 3. **End Session**

Task View allows you to see all opened apps you have on the Hub, and you can select which Window to jump to

On the bottom right of your Surface Hub you have a few items:

- **Quick Actions**
- 2. **Action Center**
- 3. **Date & Time** Selecting on of these opens a small window just above

Under Quick Actions you will see several options you can use.


You can adjust the speaker volume and screen brightness

You also have quick access to the System Settings as well


Action Center shows you all notifications that come through on the **Surface Hub**

- Got to Full Screen











Important Buttons on your Surface Hub 2s


- 1. The Power Button
- 2. Volume Controls
- 3. Input Selection



After you powered on the Surface Hub by pressing the power button, Go to settings to connect to Wi-Fi, Follow these steps







- 1. Tap on the Start button on your main Hub screen
- 2. Tap the All Apps Menu option and scroll down to find the Settings option
- 3. In settings, tap on Network & Internet
