CLIMATE CHANGE LABELS ON GAS PUMPS

Historic North American vote: On January 26, 2015, West Vancouver unanimously passed a resolution “that all vendors of retail petroleum products in Canada be legislated to provide [climate change] warning labels on all pump handles.” It has since been endorsed by over 50 communities in Canada and is also being pursued by several U.S. cities. Recently, the City of Guelph has been exploring implementing the idea. Is Waterloo next?
