

# REGULATION 2. VACANT POSITIONS

1. An officer position shall be publicly declared vacant by the Chief Returning Officer, or by the President in the case of a vacancy for the Chief Returning Officer, when:
  - 1.1. The term of office has expired and no replacement has been found;
  - 1.2. In the case of the President-Elect, the position is unfilled at the end of the General Meeting if there is no President-Elect;
  - 1.3. An officer resigns or is removed from office.
2. In the event of a vacancy, the positions shall be filled according to the following:
  - 2.1. The office of the President shall be filled in accordance with the Constitution;
  - 2.2. In the event of a vacancy in any other Executive Officer position, the duties of the vacant position shall fall to the remainder of the Executive and be divided as they see fit;
  - 2.3. In the event of a vacancy in any Executive Officer position, the President shall receive nominations for that position at any time;
  - 2.4. If a nomination is received, the Chief Returning Officer shall issue a special election call-out for additional nominations and, if none are received, the position shall be declared acclaimed;
  - 2.5. In the event multiple nominations are received, the Chief Returning Officer shall conduct a vote per Constitution;
