

Adobe

- Beginning March 1, Adobe Creative Suite products will not be available for purchase through their Cumulative Licensing Program (CLP)
 - Some non-CS products still available including Elements, Premiere and Acrobat software
 - Will continue to be sold at IST Service Desk until supply runs out or we are no longer permitted to redistribute
- Adobe CS products will now be licensed through a subscription service
 - Requires client pay for 12 month term
- Adobe has no suggestions for managing large number of subscriptions, unless a campus agreement is purchased
 - Not a viable option as annual agreement costs far exceeds our current dollar amounts spent

Microsoft Campus Agreement

Included in the Desktop Campus with Enterprise Client Access License (CAL) agreement

- Office 2010 & 2013 Pro Plus - 32 and 64 bit - and Office 2011 for Mac
- Windows 7 and 8 Enterprise upgrade only - 32 and 64 bit
- Software Assurance including upgrade rights
