- Ensure graduates are in numerical order based on their name cards.
- Work collaboratively with the other stage assistant and Transition Specialist to resolve any issues that arise.
- Identify where late or special circumstance grads need to be inserted into the procession.

The Commitment

- Attend a mandatory one-hour training session.
- Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled start time to check in, pick up any necessary supplies, and head to your designated area.
