Our tradition of convocation

The ritual of convocation is a tradition that honours the roots of the University, and is, at the same time, a beginning for students who now enter a new stage in their lives.

We welcome guests on this celebratory occasion and thank you for being present to share in it.

Both the symbols and the ceremony of convocation look back far beyond the beginning of the University of Waterloo, back to the centuries of university life in Western civilization which Waterloo joined six decades ago. The founders of this University were eager from the beginning to make it part of that long tradition, although they proudly asserted that they were building a new and innovative university, with close ties to industry and an emphasis on practical knowledge for building the future.

On this day, as ancient customs mix with the use of up-to-date technology and the exuberance of a new generation, Convocation connects a forward-looking university with the traditions that universities have observed as long as they have existed.

The University of Waterloo grew out of an older institution, Waterloo College. A still older one, the University of St. Jerome's College, soon became federated with it, and the College of Optometry of Ontario joined the family in 1967. Although all these institutions were newcomers compared with Oxford and Harvard and the Jagiellonian, the connection to the traditional role and style of a university remains clear.

Tradition underlies the proceedings of today's convocation, the continuity of this University with centuries of academic experience. Passion brings the proceedings to life, along with the enthusiasm with which the University recognizes new achievements and new ideas.

A CALLING TOGETHER

Students graduate at the end of a program of study, leading to a degree with a traditional name: Bachelor, Master, or Doctor. On this day, their families and friends celebrate their success and their transition from one status in life to another. Convocation has been, for the past nine hundred years, a meeting of the whole University community at which symbols are displayed, participants wear special attire to emphasize their official roles, and speakers share their wisdom and the values that the University seeks to teach. Convocation (the name comes from Latin, which was once the chief language of higher education) is a calling together of new graduates to receive the symbols of their accomplishment, and a calling together of the older members of the University to be witnesses and join in the celebration.

CONNECTING WITH TRADITION

At Waterloo's first convocation in June 1960, the guest speaker was James J. Talman of the University of Western Ontario, who told the audience a little about the history of Waterloo County and its industry. "The greatest resource we still have is the minds of the people," Talman said, "and this resource still remains to be developed to its full potential. The people of the Grand Valley clearly appreciate this fact. As we see the success with which they developed the physical resources in the past, we can only conclude that they will be just as successful in developing the intellectual resources of the future. The University of Waterloo can look forward to a brilliant and successful future."

THE PROCESSION

The most impressive part of the ceremony may be the procession that begins it. The graduating students will come in first, and as they fill up the main body of the hall they will give the impression that today's ceremony really is, as convocation used to be, a ceremonial meeting of the whole University community.

After the graduating students have come in, faculty members enter walking two by two, followed by University officials, all in their academic finery. Near the end of the procession, a selected faculty member will carry the mace, a traditional symbol of the University's authority.

The final party to arrive is the Chancellor's party. The Chancellor is the ceremonial head of the University of Waterloo. The Chancellor presides over Convocation ceremonies every June and October and awards all degrees, diplomas and certificates, including honorary degrees. The Chancellor addresses graduands and inspires them at these ceremonies.

THE MACE

This solid silver and ebony wand was given to the University in 1965 by the family of the late Stanley F. Leavine and was designed by Toronto artist Eric Aldwinckle and crafted by silversmith Harold Stacey to symbolize the University as it was at that time. It displays lions, chevrons, and the shield of the province of Ontario, from which the University holds its charter to grant degrees.

The symbolic theme of the mace is unity amid diversity, and tension in the creative intellectual process that strives to bring forth a new individual. The design of the mace interprets this theme in the idiom of the life process: from the seeds at the base of the stave the mace grows in unity and strength until it differentiates by a four-fold separation into diverse elements.





The four-fold diversity is significant because of the four faculties existing at the time the mace was presented to the University and as well of the four church-related colleges federated and affiliated with the University. These diverse elements together form a crown, and the point of the crown, while tending toward a union, do not quite touch. They remain as individuals suspended in tension and yet engaged in deep harmony. This creative process is focused not on the traditional spherical orb of static perfection but rather on an elliptical silver ovum – the egg-shaped symbol of creativity – the marvelous potential of a new individual life.

THE COAT OF ARMS AND MOTTO

The lions and chevrons also appear on the shield that is the University's coat of arms and that is imprinted on the graduates' diplomas. Derived from traditional heraldry, it has been used since 1961 and was registered with the Court of the Lord Lyon in 1987. The shield uses the official colours of gold, black, and white, and its symbols refer to the University's base in the cities of Kitchener and Waterloo. The unusual double chevrons were borrowed from the coat of arms of Lord Kitchener of Khartoum, and the red lions are like those on the coat of arms of the Duke of Wellington, victor at the 1815 Battle of Waterloo. The lions also reflect the tough and innovative spirit of the University's founders and builders, and the black and white in the chevron are the colours of Prussia, reflecting the Germanic background of many Waterloo County settlers. Beneath the shield appears the University's motto, *Concordia cum veritate*, "In harmony with truth."

DEGREES AND HONORARY DEGREES

Presentations of earned and honorary degrees, and the speeches associated with them, take up most of the time at Convocation. Undergraduate and graduate degrees are awarded in each of our six faculties: the faculties of Arts, Engineering, Environment, Health, Mathematics and Science. Also included are students who attended our colleges, St. Jerome's University, St. Paul's University College and Renison University College.

In addition to "earned" degrees awarded to students who have met the requirements through years of effort, the University of Waterloo confers "honorary" degrees to individuals who have been designated by the Senate, the University's academic governing body, as deserving special honour. They, too, receive hoods, lined with the colour of the faculty that nominated them or with specially designated colours for other kinds of achievement.

By tradition, public service is recognized with a Doctor of Laws degree even in a university that does not regularly teach law. The individuals receiving honorary degrees are introduced during the ceremony, and a brief citation is read to explain their various accomplishments deserving of recognition by a university. One of the honorands will address convocation after the degree has been given.

Honorary Doctorates

An honorary degree (*honoris causa*) is the highest honour conferred by the University. Through the conferring of honorary degrees, the University of Waterloo seeks to recognize outstanding achievement, whether academic or through service to society.



DIANNE SAXE

LLB, PhD

Doctor of Environmental Studies, *honoris causa*

Dr. Dianne Saxe is one of Canada's leading environmental lawyers. She has made significant contributions to Ontario as a practitioner of environmental law for over 45 years, as an influential author of several important environmental law books and articles, and, most recently, as the Environmental Commissioner of Ontario. Throughout her career, Dr. Saxe has informed Ontarians of their environmental rights and duties, and of the crucial importance of addressing environmental challenges. As the Environmental Commissioner of Ontario, she played a key role in contributing to the public life of Ontarians through extensive analysis of the government's commitments to protecting the environment and engaging the public in conversations about Ontario's sustainable future.



CAROL LEAMAN

Carol Leaman holds a Master of Accounting Degree as well as a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Economics and Accounting from the University of Waterloo. In 2013, she received the prestigious designation as a Fellow of Chartered Professional Accountants (FCPA). As a visionary, serial entrepreneur, and community leader who personifies the Waterloo spirit of innovation, she is committed to creating work environments that foster the success of their employees. Leaman is currently the CEO of Axonify and has overseen the successful acquisition of numerous companies such as MLevel (acquired by Axonify), Fakespace (acquired by Mechdyne Corporation), RSS Solutions (acquired by Visiprise Inc.), and PostRank (acquired by Google).



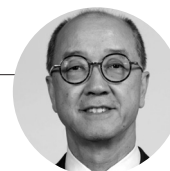
JOHN HELLIWELL

Doctor of Letters, *honoris causa*

Professor John Helliwell is acclaimed for his pioneering and prolific work in macro-economic modeling, energy economics and policy, and global trade flows. He is also well-known for his contributions to the annual World Happiness Report, a United Nations publication that ranks countries according to national well-being. The Report has been influential in encouraging governments worldwide to think beyond the narrow confines of gross national product and per capita income as they develop policies and strive towards sustainable development. Helliwell's excellence has been recognized with honours that include Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, Distinguished Fellow of the Canadian Institute for Advanced Research, and Officer of the Order of Canada.



TONY CHAN

BS, MS, PhD

Doctor of Mathematics, *honoris causa*

THURSDAY, JUNE 16 / MORNING CEREMONY

Professor Tony Chan is an esteemed leader in computational models and algorithms for image processing. He received his Ph.D. in Computer Science from Stanford University, followed by a Research Fellowship at Caltech. He also holds an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Strathclyde. After serving as president of The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology for nearly a decade, Chan became the third president of the King Abdullah University of Science and Technology in 2018. He is a member of the US National Academy of Engineering, and a Fellow of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE), the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) and Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (SIAM). Chan was also awarded the 2020 SIAM Prize for Distinguished Service to the Profession.

Dr. Virginia Ann Heath completed a Bachelor of Science degree at the University of British Columbia, and Dr. John William Heath completed his Bachelor of Science at McGill. Both then completed MScs and MDs in clinical medicine at McGill. After postgraduate medical training in Halifax, Winnipeg, and Vancouver they set up a practice in Campbell River, B.C. and participated in many clinical research studies. In 1985, they established Yellow Island Aquaculture on Quadra Island, B.C., which quickly became a centre for aquaculture research, with numerous publications, including contributions in *Nature and Science*. They received the 2013 NSERC Synergy award for collaborative research and they have hosted numerous Waterloo students.

DOUGLAS FREGIN

Doctor of Engineering, *honoris causa*

Douglas Fregin has been a leader in the telecommunications industry for over 35 years. He co-founded Research In Motion (RIM), which launched the world's first smartphone (the BlackBerry 5180). In 2013, he co-founded Quantum Valley Investments, driving the Region of Waterloo to the forefront of the global quantum technologies industry. He has donated millions towards educational and research programs at the University of Waterloo, enabling the establishment of the Waterloo Undergraduate Program in Nanotechnology (2005), the Waterloo Institute of Nanotechnology (2009), and the Mike & Ophelia Quantum-Nano Centre (2012). He received a Technical Emmy Award with Kodak and the National Film Board of Canada, and was awarded the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal in recognition of his achievements. In 2016, he was appointed a Member of the Order of Canada.

VALERIE DAVIDSON

BEng, MSc, PhD

Doctor of Engineering, *honoris causa*

Valerie Davidson is a Professor Emerita in the University of Guelph's School of Engineering, where she was a faculty member for 24 years. During this time, she developed innovative courses in bio-process and food engineering, and was a recipient of the Provost's Award for Innovation in Teaching. Her group developed ground-breaking, fundamentals-based, engineering models of complex food processing systems to improve product quality and safety. Davidson recently consulted for the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization to develop tools for food safety decision-making. For over three decades, Professor Davidson has been an exceptional citizen within the engineering community and a dedicated champion of diversity in the profession. While serving as NSERC Chair for Women in Science and Engineering, she founded the Ontario Network of Women in Engineering (ONWiE), now a pan-Canadian collaboration that inspires the next generation of engineers. In 2016, she received the Ontario Professional Engineers' Award for Citizenship.

Distinguished Professors Emeriti

The Distinguished Professor Emeritus designation is made to faculty members who have had a distinguished record of service in teaching and research in the University. The honorary award is granted upon, or shortly after, retirement.



MARK E. HAVITZ

BSc, MSc, PhD

Department of Recreation
and Leisure Studies

TUESDAY, JUNE 14 / MORNING CEREMONY

Dr. Mark Havitz was a professor in the Department of Recreation and Leisure Studies from 1992-2019, serving as department chair from 2008-2016. He is well known for his work in the theoretical advancement of ego-involvement, psychological commitment and loyalty, and marketing services to marginalized people, as well as his creative autoethnographic accounts and retrospective techniques. Havitz was honoured with a Fellow in the Academy of Leisure Sciences in 2000 and received the Theodore and Franklin Roosevelt Award from the National Recreation and Park Association in 2017. In 2021, he also received the Leisure Scholar Award, the highest recognition bestowed by the Canadian Association of Leisure Studies.



ALICE KUZNIAR

BA, MA, PhD

Department of German and Slavic Studies

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 15 / AFTERNOON CEREMONY

Alice Kuzniar is one of the leading figures in German studies today, and is well known for her scholarly work in the earlier periods of German literary history, especially German classicism and romanticism. She is a noted film scholar, both in German-language film and world cinema. She is also well known as a leading thinker in the field of cultural studies, producing ground-breaking work in the areas of gender and queer studies as well as animal studies. Kuzniar's contributions have been recognized with a University research chair, two Alexander von Humboldt fellowships, two Outstanding Performance awards from the Faculty of Arts, and the Excellence in Arts Research Award.



STUART MCGILL

BPE, MSc, PhD

Department of Kinesiology

TUESDAY, JUNE 14 / MORNING CEREMONY

Dr. Stuart McGill was a professor in the Department of Kinesiology from 1987-2017, serving as department chair from 2006-2009. He is internationally regarded for his work in spine biomechanics, investigating mechanisms of low-back injury and how to prevent and rehabilitate low-back pain and optimize performance. He has published more than 250 scientific papers and five books, mentored more than 40 graduate students, and taught thousands of clinicians and practitioners in courses and workshops around the world. Dr. McGill is the Chief Scientific Officer for Backfitpro Inc. and was named a Member of the Order of Canada in 2020.



JAMES W. ST. G. WALKER

CM, FRSC, PhD

Department of History

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 15 / AFTERNOON CEREMONY

James W. St. G. Walker has been widely recognized for his pioneering work in African-Canadian history, human rights, Holocaust studies, race relations, Indigenous history, and antisemitism, as well as immigration and other Canadian public policies. His publications have been widely recognized and his book *The Black Loyalists* was republished in 2017 by University of Toronto Press as part of the Canada 150 Collection, a collection of outstanding books that have shaped Canada as a nation. Walker's contributions to Canadian society have been recognized with honours that include the Bora Laskin National Fellowship in Human Rights Research, Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, and Member of the Order of Canada.



IAN GOULDEN

BMath, MMath, PhD, FRSC
Department of Combinatorics
and Optimization

THURSDAY, JUNE 16 / EVENING CEREMONY

Professor Ian Goulden received his PhD in Statistics from the University of Waterloo in 1979. He joined the Department of Combinatorics & Optimization in 1980, and was promoted to full professor in 1990, before retiring in 2019. Goulden is a leader in the field of enumerative combinatorics, and co-authored the influential textbook *Combinatorial Enumeration* with David Jackson. In 2010, he was elected as a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada. Goulden is an exceptional teacher, and received the Faculty of Mathematics Award for Distinction in Teaching in 2009. He is also an accomplished administrator who served three terms as chair of Combinatorics & Optimization, and one term as dean of the Faculty of Mathematics.



KATHRYN HARE

BMath, PhD, FCMS
Department of Pure Mathematics

THURSDAY, JUNE 16 / EVENING CEREMONY

Professor Kathryn Hare retired from the Department of Pure Mathematics in July 2021, after joining in 1988 as the first female professor. Hare has an extensive research portfolio on harmonic analysis, fractals, thin sets and multipliers and maximal operators. She has supervised dozens of postdoctoral, PhD and master's students, many of whom earned prizes for research excellence, including a Morgan Prize winner, and an AIM Fellowship winner. Hare is a Fellow of the Canadian Mathematical Society, and the recipient of an honorary doctorate from Chalmers University, and the Faculty of Mathematics Award for Distinction in Teaching. She tirelessly served the University, notably as department chair from 2014 to 2018.



WILLIAM BOBIER

BSc, OD, MSc, PhD
School of Optometry and Vision Science

FRIDAY, JUNE 17 / AFTERNOON CEREMONY

Professor William Bobier completed his Bachelor of Science degree at Queen's University and then an Optometry degree at the University of Waterloo. After one year of private practice in Optometry, he returned to Waterloo to complete his Master of Science, then, moved to the University of Cambridge for his PhD. He joined the School of Optometry and Vision Science at the University of Waterloo as a faculty member in 1987 and rose to be become director. Bobier retired in December of 2019, after a distinguished 29-year career within the School. He remains active in research and graduate student supervision.



RAYMOND LEGGE

BSc, PhD
Department of Chemical Engineering

Professor Emeritus Raymond Legge's record of scholarship, teaching, and service to the Department of Chemical Engineering and the University of Waterloo is exemplary and extends more than 37 years. He has made groundbreaking contributions to the development of biosensors, environmental monitoring and remediation, green bioprocesses, and water treatment and monitoring. Deeply committed to improving engineering education, Legge has served on more than 50 committees within his department and across the university, including several undergraduate task forces. In his roles as associate chair, associate dean, and assistant vice-president, Graduate Studies he has helped shape the engineering curriculum and elevate Waterloo to one of the most prominent engineering schools in the world. During his career he taught more than 7,000 students and received the Sandford Fleming Foundation Teaching Excellence Award on two occasions.

FLORA T.T. NG

BSc, MSc, PhD

Department of Chemical Engineering



Professor Flora T.T. Ng joined the Department of Chemical Engineering at the University of Waterloo in 1987, after nearly a decade working with the Canada Centre for Mineral and Energy Technology, where she rose to assistant director, research programs. At Waterloo, her group is internationally recognized for innovation in catalytic processes and “green” chemistry. She has co-authored more than 250 journal and conference papers, delivered more than 100 invited talks, and supervised over 140 undergraduate and graduate students. She held a University Research Chair from 2006 to 2013 and was appointed a University Professor – Waterloo’s highest academic honour – in 2008. She is a former president of the Canadian Catalysis Foundation and a Fellow of both the Chemical Institute of Canada (CIC) and the Royal Society of Canada.

In his over 40 years at the University of Waterloo, Professor Keith Hipel has established a distinguished record of scholarship, teaching and service. He is an international authority in the field of environmental systems engineering, with profound impacts on the management of water, energy, and natural resources. His contributions to engineering education include co-supervision of 87 graduate students, founding of three highly successful exchange programs with leading universities in Japan, and serving as chair of the Board of Governors of Renison University College. Hipel has received 67 national and international honours, including election to Officer of the Order of Canada, President of the Academy of Science within the Royal Society of Canada, Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Engineering. He is also an international Member of the US National Academy of Engineering and Killam Prize Laureate.

He obtained his BSc in Health Studies, a Certificate in Gerontology, MA in Sociology, and PhD in Sociology all from the University of Waterloo. Dr. Hirdes has published over 250 peer-reviewed studies, book chapters, and clinical manuals focusing broadly on health systems and services for vulnerable health populations. He has received numerous awards for his contributions to the fields of aging, mental health, and health information systems as well as his excellence in graduate student mentorship.

Geoffrey Fong is renowned internationally for his pioneering research on population health and his leadership as founder and chief principal investigator of the International Tobacco Control Policy Evaluation (ITC) Project – a project involving over 150 researchers across 31 countries. His contributions to reducing the global tobacco epidemic include research on improved risk messaging on tobacco products alongside his work with international governments to adopt national tobacco-reduction policies and practices. One of the top-cited researchers in the world, Fong has been recognized with honours that include Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, O. Harold Warwick Prize, the Governor General's Innovation Award (ITC Project), and Officer of the Order of Canada.

She is also an elected member of the International Statistical Institute and a Fellow of the Institute of Mathematical Statistics. She won the Waksberg Award of Survey Methodology in 2008.

Professor Stephan Lambert completed his undergraduate degree in Mechanical Engineering at the University of Waterloo in 1982, received his master's degree from Queen's University in 1984, and returned to Waterloo to complete his doctorate. He joined Waterloo's Mechanical and Mechatronics Engineering Department as an Assistant Professor in 1988. For 15 years, his group developed models to predict and ultimately reduce fatigue, fracture, and stress corrosion cracking in Canadian pipeline infrastructure. His recent work has advanced the design of load-bearing automotive components using forged magnesium alloys. He was the Design Processes Theme Lead within the AUTO21 Network of Centres of Excellence (2004-2015), the Waterloo-NSERC Chair in Design Engineering (2004-2016), and the Canadian Task Leader for Fatigue in the Magnesium Front End Research and Development Project (2006-2012). He has been the Faculty Advisor for Waterloo's Formula Motorsports team since 1996.

Waterloo brings home the gold

Alumni Gold Medal recipients share in the pursuit of discovery, so we created a lasting symbol to honour their achievements.

Since 1970, Alumni Gold Medals have graced the convocation gowns of our top undergraduate and graduate students. The Royal Canadian Mint produced these medals in the past – but in the true spirit of Waterloo, we’ve decided to make them ourselves.

Carefully crafted on campus in state-of-the-art labs, each medal is created out of nickel superalloy using a 3D printer. The surface is finished by hand to produce a brilliant shine. Through the process of electroplating, the medal is then coated in 24-carat gold. The result is a tribute to Waterloo’s most accomplished graduates, made for each proud recipient by members of the University community.

Our tradition of regalia

THE GOWN

At the University of Waterloo, as at most universities, academic robes are worn only on these special occasions. In the Middle Ages, robes were everyday clothing, and some students were so poor they had nothing else to wear. The black wrapper now called a “gown” served them as jacket, coat and sometimes bedclothes. Stone college buildings of the Middle Ages were unheated and the colourful “hood” could be pulled up to help keep out the cold wind. Today, the officers of the University, faculty members and graduating students all wear garments that are symbolic, not functional.

The scholars and students in long-ago universities were generally monks and other members of church orders. Over time, their vestments came to identify their universities. There are many variations, and the exact hood, gown or hat worn by an individual are determined by the university where they qualified. The array of colours and styles demonstrates the worldwide range of universities from which Waterloo’s faculty have come.

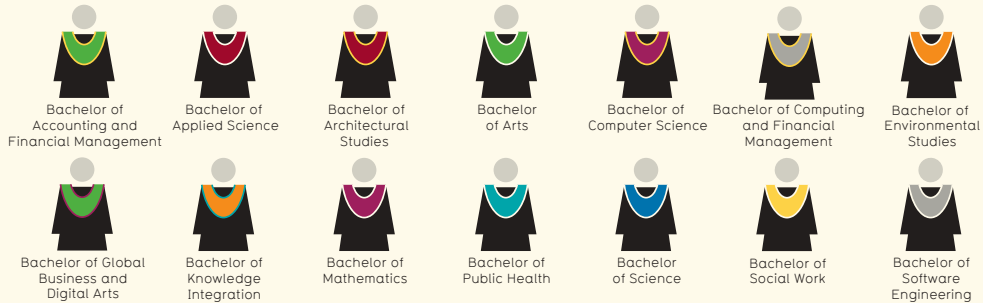
THE HOOD

Hoods are unique in design and colour to each degree and each university. The academic dress chosen for Waterloo is patterned after that of Oxford, the world’s oldest English-speaking university. The chief officers on the convocation platform – the chancellor (the ceremonial head of the University) and the president (who is also vice-chancellor) – wear gowns of the Oxford cut and trim, each with its own distinctive colour. The gowns worn by recipients of honorary degrees have the same design, as do the black gowns worn by candidates for regular degrees, and the red-and-green gowns which are Waterloo’s regalia for Doctor of Philosophy degrees.

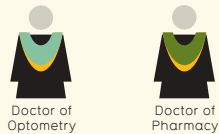
The ritual at convocation reflects the old custom that anyone in a university could wear a gown, but a hood was the symbol for a degree.

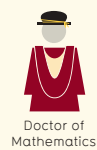
