Our tradition of convocation

The ritual of convocation is a tradition that honours the roots of the university, and is, at the same time, a beginning for students who now enter a new stage in their lives.

We welcome guests on this celebratory occasion and thank you for being present to share in it.

Both the symbols and the ceremony of convocation look back far beyond the beginning of the University of Waterloo, back to the centuries of university life in Western civilization which Waterloo joined six decades ago. The founders of this University were eager from the beginning to make it part of that long tradition, although they proudly asserted that they were building a new and innovative university, with close ties to industry and an emphasis on practical knowledge for building the future.

On this day, as ancient customs mix with the use of up-to-date technology and exuberance of a new generation, convocation connects a forward-looking university with the traditions that universities have observed as long as they have existed.

The University of Waterloo grew out of an older institution, Waterloo College. A still older one, the University of St. Jerome's College, soon became federated with it, and the College of Optometry of Ontario joined the family in 1967. Although all these institutions were newcomers compared with Oxford and Harvard and the Jagiellonian, the connection to the traditional role and style of a university remains clear.

Tradition underlies the proceedings of today's convocation, the continuity of this University with centuries of academic experience. Passion brings the proceedings to life, along with the enthusiasm with which the University recognizes new achievements and new ideas.

A CALLING TOGETHER

Students graduate at the end of a program of study, leading to a degree with a traditional name: Bachelor, Master, or Doctor. On this day, their families and friends celebrate their success and their transition from one status in life to another. Convocation has been, for the past nine hundred years, a meeting of the whole university community at which symbols are displayed, participants wear special attire to emphasize their official roles, and speakers share their wisdom and the values that the university seeks to teach. Convocation (the name comes from Latin, which was once the primary language of higher education) is a calling together of new graduates to receive the symbols of their accomplishments, and a calling together of the older members of the university to witness and join in the celebration.

CONNECTING WITH TRADITION

At Waterloo's first convocation in June 1960, the guest speaker was James J. Talman of the University of Western Ontario (now Western University), who told the audience a little about the history of Waterloo County and its industry. "The greatest resource we still have is the minds of the people," Talman said. "And this resource still remains to be developed to its full potential. The people of the Grand Valley clearly appreciate this fact. As we see the success with which they developed the physical resources in the past we can only conclude that they will be just as successful in developing the intellectual resources of the future. The University of Waterloo can look forward to a brilliant and successful future."

THE PROCESSION

The most impressive part of the ceremony may be the procession that begins it. The graduating students will come in first, and as they fill up the main body of the hall, they will give the impression that today's ceremony really is, as convocation used to be, a ceremonial meeting of the whole University community.

After the graduating students have come in, the academic procession will begin. First to enter is the ceremonial Eagle Staff, a symbolic representation of the continuous presence of Indigenous Peoples of these lands, carried in by an Eagle Staff carrier. Next, a selected faculty member will carry the mace, a traditional symbol of the University's authority. Then faculty members enter, walking two by two, dressed in their academic finery.

The final party to arrive is the chancellor's party. The chancellor is the ceremonial head of the University of Waterloo. The chancellor presides over convocation ceremonies every June and October and awards all degrees, diplomas and certificates, including honorary degrees. The chancellor offers an inspirational message for the graduands at these ceremonies.

THE MACE

The solid silver and ebony wand was given to the University in 1965 by the family of the late Stanley F. Leavine and was designed by Toronto artist Eric Aldwinckle and crafted by silversmith Harold Stacey to symbolize the University as it was at that time. It displays lions, chevrons and the shield of the province of Ontario, from which the University holds its charter to grant degrees.

The symbolic theme of the mace is unity amid diversity, and tension in the creative intellectual process that strives to bring forth a new individual. The design of the mace interprets this theme in the idiom of the life process: from the seeds at the base of the stave the mace grows in unity and strength until it differentiates by a four-fold separation into diverse elements.





The four-fold diversity is significant because of the four faculties existing at the time the mace was presented to the University, and the four church-related colleges federated and affiliated with the University. These diverse elements together form a crown, and the point of the crown, while tending toward a union, do not quite touch. They remain as individuals suspended in tension and yet engaged in deep harmony. This creative process is focused not on the traditional spherical orb of static perfection but rather on an elliptical silver ovum – the egg-shaped symbol of creativity – the marvelous potential of a new individual life.

THE COAT OF ARMS AND MOTTO

The lions and chevrons also appear on the shield that is the University's coat of arms and is imprinted on the graduates' diplomas. Derived from traditional heraldry, it has been used since 1961 and was registered with the Court of the Lord Lyon in 1987. The shield uses the official colours of gold, black and white, and its symbols refer to the University's base in the cities of Kitchener and Waterloo. The unusual double chevrons were borrowed from the coat of arms of Lord Kitchener of Khartoum, and the red lions are like those on the coat of arms of the Duke of Wellington, victor at the 1815 Battle of Waterloo. The lions also reflect the tough and innovative spirit of the University's founders and builders, and the black and white in the chevron are the colours of Prussia, reflecting the Germanic background of many Waterloo County settlers. Beneath the shield appears the University's motto: *Concordia cum veritate*, "In harmony with truth."

DEGREES AND HONORARY DEGREES

Presentations of earned and honorary degrees, and the speeches associated with them, take up most of the time at convocation. Undergraduate and graduate degrees are awarded in each of our six faculties: Arts, Engineering, Environment, Health, Mathematics and Science. Also included are students who attended our colleges, Conrad Grebel University College, Renison University College, St. Jerome's University and United College.

In addition to "earned" degrees awarded to students who have met the requirements through years of effort, the University of Waterloo confers "honorary" degrees to individuals who have been designated by the Senate, the University's academic governing body, as deserving special honour. They, too, receive hoods, lined with the colour of the faculty that nominated them or with specially designated colours for other kinds of achievement.

By tradition, public service is recognized with a Doctor of Laws degree even in a university that does not regularly teach law. The individuals receiving honorary degrees are introduced during the ceremony, and a brief citation is read to explain their various accomplishments deserving of recognition by a university. One of the honorands will address convocation after the degree has been given.

EAGLE STAFF

On September 22, 2022, the University of Waterloo held a Commitment Ceremony pledging action toward decolonization, Indigenization and reconciliation. Weaving in the knowledge, ways of knowing, and understandings of First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples equips the Waterloo community, especially Waterloo graduates, with the tools and knowledge they need to create a better future for all. The commitment was formalized through a Pipe Ceremony, after which Vivek Goel, president and vice-chancellor, was given the name “Ogiima” (meaning leader) and presented with gifts of an eagle feather and two Wampum belts. Our recommitment is formally acknowledged in a special ceremony each fall.

Building on the desire and responsibility to incorporate Indigenous perspectives, the University of Waterloo community came together for a ceremony on March 27, 2023, to welcome an Eagle Staff to the University.

An Eagle Staff is an important element of the Indigenous relationship to Earth and those that have protected it. It reflects the wisdom, strength and honour of those who carry it, representing different nations across Turtle Island. By welcoming the Eagle Staff, the University acknowledges the responsibility to recognize, accept and incorporate Indigenous perspectives in how we teach, govern and behave as an institution. The Eagle Staff is present at all ceremonies, celebrations and convocations.

The University of Waterloo honours and welcomes the Eagle Staff, a symbol of Indigenous strength, spirit and care. This signifies Waterloo’s commitment to incorporating First Nations, Métis and Inuit perspectives into the University’s governance, structure, and mission. It serves as a beacon of reconciliation on our shared path forward.

Honorary doctorates

An honorary degree (honoris causa) is the highest honour conferred by the University. Through the conferring of honorary degrees, the University of Waterloo seeks to recognize outstanding achievement, whether academic or through service to society.

JOHN ENGLISH

BA, AM, PhD, FRSC
Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*

Dr. John English is one of Canada's most acclaimed, best-selling historians and experts in international relations. He is an Officer of the Order of Canada, a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, and has the Order of Merit of Germany. English was the member of Parliament for the federal riding of Kitchener from 1993 to 1997, serving with distinction as the parliamentary secretary to the minister of Intergovernmental Affairs. He earned a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Waterloo, and was for four decades an outstanding member of Waterloo's history department and founding executive director of the Centre for International Governance Innovation. He is now a Senior Fellow at Trinity College at the University of Toronto and chairs the Canadian International Council.

PAUL CORKUM

PhD
Doctor of Science, *honoris causa*

Dr. Paul Corkum is a pioneering Canadian physicist renowned for his foundational contributions to attosecond science – the study of ultrafast phenomena on the scale of attoseconds (10^{-18} seconds). He earned his PhD in theoretical physics from Lehigh University in 1972. Corkum joined the National Research Council of Canada (NRC) in 1973, where he transitioned to experimental physics and developed groundbreaking models of atomic ionization. His recollision model enabled the generation of attosecond laser pulses, allowing scientists to observe electron dynamics in real time. Corkum holds a joint chair in Attosecond Photonics at the University of Ottawa and the NRC. His numerous accolades include the 2022 Wolf Prize in Physics and the 2025 APS Medal for Exceptional Achievement in Research.

TIM JACKSON

Tim Jackson is an entrepreneur, venture capitalist, not-for-profit leader and community builder. He is the president and chief executive officer of Shad, Canada's premier high school student summer program. He co-founded Tech Capital Partners, an early-stage venture capital firm and led the Accelerator Centre, an incubator for technology startups. He was executive-president at the MaRS Discovery District, one of the world's largest urban innovation hubs. As a University of Waterloo Accounting graduate, Jackson has a long history of service at Waterloo. He held the position of vice-president, University Relations in addition to five years on the Board of Governors and seven years as chair of the Student Venture Fund investment committee. Jackson was recognized with the prestigious title of Fellow Chartered Public Accountant for his exceptional service to the profession and his community.

ARMUGHAN AHMAD

Armughan Ahmad is a global technology executive, investor and board director recognized for his leadership in artificial intelligence and digital transformation. He currently serves as executive chairman of RxFood AI and general partner at Vision Studio Ventures, a venture capital firm backing early-stage AI founders. He also advises ServiceNow, TELUS, and OMERS as a senior AI strategist. Previously, Armughan was chief executive officer of Appen, a publicly traded company providing AI training data to leading technology firms including Google, Microsoft, Meta and Nvidia. He has also held senior leadership roles as president of KPMG Digital and Dell EMC, where he led global Data Center Cloud and High-Performance Computing business, and at HP and 3Com. Ahmad serves on the board of Trillium Health Partners and is the co-founder and board director of CILAR (Coalition of Innovation Leaders Advancing respect), advancing AI skill development and inclusive economic growth.

Neil Cawse is the founder and chief executive officer of Geotab, the world's largest commercial telematics company. An engineer by training and entrepreneur by instinct, he founded Geotab in 2000 to help businesses make better decisions through vehicle data. Under his leadership, the company has grown into a global leader and is recognized among the fastest-growing technology companies in North America. Known for his long-term thinking and hands-on approach, Cawse continues to guide product design and engineering for Geotab. In 2015, he was named Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year.

Dr. Gina Cody is an engineer and business leader who has helped shape Canada's cities and communities through decades of work in the private sector. As executive chair and owner of CCI Group Inc., she led complex engineering projects for major developers, financial institutions and public agencies across the country. Cody was the first woman to earn a PhD in building engineering from Concordia University, and she remains a strong advocate for inclusion in STEM. Her leadership and generosity led Concordia to name its Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science in her honour, recognizing both her professional achievements and commitment to the next generation.

The distinguished professor emeritus designation is made to faculty members who have had a distinguished record of service in teaching and research in the University. The honorary award is granted upon, or shortly after, retirement.

Dr. Bryan Smale is director of the Canadian Index of Wellbeing in the Faculty of Health, and professor emeritus in the Department of Recreation and Leisure Studies at the University of Waterloo. He received his PhD in Geography from the University of Western Ontario and both his Bachelor of Arts and Master's degrees in Leisure Studies from the University of Waterloo. Smale is currently a member of Statistics Canada's Advisory Committee on Social Conditions, research consultant on UNICEF Canada's Child and Youth Well-being Index, former chair and president of the Board of Directors of the Canadian Association of Leisure Studies.

PAUL STOLEE

Dr. Paul Stolee retired at the rank of professor from the School of Public Health Sciences at the University of Waterloo. His research is recognised for its significant impact on older persons' experiences with care systems. Stolee received the Distinguished Member Award from the Canadian Association on Gerontology, the association's highest honour. At Waterloo, he served in key governance roles including director of the University's Network for Aging Research and as interim dean of the Faculty of Health. He is also known for his exemplary student mentorship, as recognised with the University of Waterloo Award of Excellence in Graduate Supervision.

MARY HARDY

Dr. Mary Hardy's research creates bridges between theoretical actuarial science and real-world challenges in insurance and pensions. Her pioneering work on financial guarantees and risk measures drove regulatory changes, bolstering Canadian insurers during the 2007-09 financial crisis. Hardy has co-authored three books and approximately 80 papers. She served as past editor-in-chief of two leading actuarial journals and was vice-president of the Society of Actuaries, where she was instrumental in modernizing its technical curriculum. In 2012, Hardy was awarded the Finlaison Medal of the U.K. Institute and Faculty of Actuaries for services to the actuarial profession in the areas of governance, teaching, research and the application of research to practice. In 2023, she was awarded the Lifetime Volunteer Award by the Society of Actuaries.

GORDON WILLMOT

Dr. Gord Willmot was professor of actuarial science in the Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science at the University of Waterloo from 1986 to 2024. He was the inaugural Munich Re Chair in Insurance from 2001 to 2021. Willmot is an outstanding mathematician known for his foundational contributions to insurance risk modelling and ruin theory. He has published more than 100 research papers and co-authored five books. He is among the most-cited actuarial scholars of all time. His stellar contributions to graduate supervision led him to be the recipient of a prestigious Award of Excellence in Graduate Supervision in 2022.

JOHN RAVENHILL

Dr. John Ravenhill joined the University of Waterloo in 2013 as the director of the Balsillie School of International Affairs, recognizing his leadership and world-class research in global politics and international political economy. His service continued in 2019 as chair of the Department of Political Science. Ravenhill has published more than 25 books and over 200 articles and book chapters. Among many distinctions, he has received the International Political Economy Distinguished Scholar Award from the International Studies Association and is an elected Fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences in Australia. He has also taught at the universities of Virginia, Sydney, and Edinburgh, and at the Australian National University.

Dr. Peter Huck is a retired professor of civil engineering at the University of Waterloo and a leading expert in drinking water treatment. He held the longest-running NSERC Industrial Research Chair in the program's history, serving for more than 30 years. His work on advanced treatment technologies has shaped drinking water policy and practice across Canada and internationally. A trusted advisor to government and industry, Huck played a key role in the Walkerton inquiry into drinking water safety, and he has received numerous national and international awards for his research, mentorship and contributions to public health and environmental protection.

Dr. Ranjini Jha retired from the School of Accounting and Finance in 2024, following a 26-year career at the University of Waterloo. As a trailblazer in experiential finance education, Jha founded the Student Investment Fund in 2012 (public equity) and the Student Venture Fund in 2017 (venture capital). Jha has received numerous awards, including the Faculty of Arts 2023 Excellence in Service Award, and the Outstanding Performance Award in 2013, 2010 and 2006.

Alumni Gold Medal recipients share in the pursuit of discovery, so we created a lasting symbol to honour their achievements.

Since 1970, Alumni Gold Medals have graced the convocation gowns of our top undergraduate and graduate students. The Royal Canadian Mint produced these medals in the past – but in the true spirit of Waterloo, we’ve decided to make them ourselves.

Carefully crafted on campus in state-of-the-art labs, each medal is created out of nickel superalloy using a 3D printer. The surface is finished by hand to produce a brilliant shine. Through the process of electroplating, the medal is then coated in 24-carat gold. The result is a tribute to Waterloo’s most accomplished graduates, made for each proud recipient by members of the University community.

Our tradition of regalia

THE GOWN

At the University of Waterloo, as at most universities, academic robes are worn only on these special occasions. In the Middle Ages, robes were everyday clothing, and some students were so poor they had nothing else to wear. The black wrapper now called a “gown” served them as jacket, coat and sometimes bedclothes. Stone college buildings of the Middle Ages were unheated and the colourful “hood” could be pulled up to help keep out the cold wind. Today, the officers of the University, faculty members and graduating students all wear garments that are symbolic, not functional.

The scholars and students in long-ago universities were generally monks and other members of church orders. Over time, their vestments came to identify their universities. There are many variations, and the exact hood, gown or hat worn by an individual are determined by the university where they qualified. The array of colours and styles demonstrates the worldwide range of universities from which Waterloo’s faculty have come.
















THE HOOD

Hoods are unique in design and colour to each degree and each university. The academic dress chosen for Waterloo is patterned after that of Oxford, the world’s oldest English-speaking university. The chief officers on the convocation platform – the chancellor (the ceremonial head of the University) and the president (who is also vice-chancellor) – wear gowns of the Oxford cut and trim, each with its own distinctive colour. The gowns worn by recipients of honorary degrees have the same design, as do the black gowns worn by candidates for regular degrees, and the red-and-green gowns which are Waterloo’s regalia for Doctor of Philosophy degrees.



The ritual at convocation reflects the old custom that anyone in a university could wear a gown, but a hood was the symbol for a degree.
