The Role

- Provide hoods to Master's and PhD grad side stage during the ceremony.
- Assist Undergraduate grads with hood placement.
- Check in with the Hooding Area Supervisor upon arrival.
- Hands-on training will be provided by the Hooding Area Supervisor at the beginning of your scheduled shift.
- A short hooding orientation video will be provided through the Convocation Ambassador Teams site for Hooding Assistants to review prior to their shift.

- For this role, dress in business casual attire, consider comfortable shoes and layers as the temperature can fluctuate within the gym.

- Receive a written letter of appreciation that you can use for your annual performance appraisal.
- Note: this role will remain standing for long periods and be in close proximity with others (Hooding Assistants will be in direct contact with the majority of grads).
