Game theory is the study of strategic interactions between agents. In this course I not only cover the theory but also students engage in weekly games against each other. The primary responsibility of the TA assigned to this course will be to run the weekly games (the TA will be given the code to run the weekly games that play the different student strategies against each other). Students love this course – and I have also been told that it is a fun course to TA.

- 1. Run weekly games where the students play against each other, summarise the results, generate grades
- 2. Grade the midterm
- 3. Grade part of the final exam (typically 33-50% of the exam)

Any necessary knowledge or skills needed:

- 1. Some knowledge of game theory (ideally have taken the course)
- 2. Knowledge of Stata (the code for running the weekly games is in Stata). If they don't know Stata they should at least know a language like R or Python.
