A Minor usually requires a student to take ten courses and a Double Degree requires even more. In most cases, this will require an Electrical and Computer Engineering student to take at least five extra courses above the regular Course Load, as some courses may count both towards the minor/double degree and towards the degree in electrical or computer engineering.
