Grad Pitch Evaluation and Selection

10 finalists will be selected to present on the presentation day. The evaluation and selection process will be completed by the IDEAs Clinic Director and Engineering Educational Developers according to the following criteria:

Activity Criteria:

- Hands-on
- Develops real world engineering-related skills
- Related to your expertise/research
- Shows students a real-world problem
- If a design problem, allow for multiple possible solutions
- If a workshop, taught clearly and with sufficient detail
- The activity can be extended to different audiences (amateur to expert)

Pitch Criteria

Create a pitch in the form of a presentation or document and include the following details:

- Description of your proposed activity
- Skills that your activity develops
- Event structure: Maximum 16 hours of teaching time. Options include hackathon style, multiple night workshop, single night workshop occurring multiple times, design days, etc.
- Target year (e.g. 1st years, 3rd years, graduate, all years)
- Target program(s)
- Ideal number of students for activity participation
- Personnel requirements
- Equipment needed and approximate budget
