## 9. UW Digital Learning Discussion

- Stephanie VP of Education from WUSA!
- Waterloo wants to develop university-wise Digital Learning Strategy guiding decision-making about digital learning/teaching
- Concerns/Opinions
  - Hard to navigate switching between online and in-person
    - Relearn how to learn in person
  - Transition difficult because of varying workloads
  - Students not incentivized to go to class if you already have all the materials available to you online and could instead be more interested in doing it in your own time
    - Class time could be used more effectively to switch online Discussion Posts to real discussion
    - Need reasons for students to go to class
  - Async. Classes are very isolating and limiting
    - Limited amount of time to contact TAs
    - Frustrating for students
  - Greater emphasis on meaningful classroom engagement
  - Hard to meet people
  - Online option can be helpful if you are on co-op or not in Waterloo
  - In-person should not be substituted for online and the option for both is more beneficial
  - Flexibility of remote course does not always work out due to travel time
  - Increased time commitment from profs. and TAs
  - Issues with technology incompatibility
