The Faculty Association is strongly committed to representing the interests and concerns of its diverse constituency and membership. We especially welcome those who would contribute to the diversification of the association's leadership.

About the Faculty Association

The Faculty Association is not a union, but officially represents all regular faculty members who hold definite term, probationary, tenured, or continuing appointments. Its principle functions include: negotiating salaries and benefits; discussing and negotiating policy changes and changes that impact faculty terms and conditions of employment; advising, protecting and providing information to faculty members; connecting with faculty members across Canada; and providing responsible governance. Service to the association is considered service to the University for the purposes of annual performance reviews, tenure, and promotion.

Board of Directors

The Board considers all matters concerning faculty relations with the University administration, University governance as it affects the association membership, and the Memorandum of Agreement. It also advises association representatives serving on the Faculty Relations Committee, where a wide range of issues related to employment and policy are considered. The Board normally meets bi-weekly on Thursday afternoons from 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., September through June.

President

The president chairs the meetings of the Board of Directors and represents the association within the University and the broader community. The president is charged with the general management and supervision of the associations' affairs and operation, including serving as a representative on the Faculty Relations Committee and as an ex-officio member of all association standing committees.
