- Medium sized city
 - o 150 000 people
 - o 128 people/km2
- On the Saguenay River
- 200 km north of Québec City
- Snow on the ground from October/November to April
- Average winter temperature: 16°C (but it can go as low as 40!)
- A prime location for outdoor enthusiasts: large lakes (Lake Saint-Jean), meandering rivers (Saguenay), towering mountains (Valin mountains) and a fjord (Saguenay Fjord) carved out of a glacial valley.






Regular undergraduate or graduate degree courses in the Modern French department of the Faculté des Lettres

TRANSFER CREDITS

Courses taken will transfer as credits (not grades) and will not affect your UWaterloo average. To receive transfer credits, students must complete two forms: one before departure and the other at the end of your studies.

- A Letter of Permission form must be completed before departing for exchange. Please submit the completed form to the the French Undergraduate Advisor for approval.
 - There is a \$25.00 processing fee, payable to the Registrar's office.
- Upon completion of the program, students must order an official transcript from their host university. The official transcript must be sent directly to Waterloo's Registrar's Office: 200 University Avenue West, Waterloo, ON, N2L 3G1.

Important: The Registrar's Office transfers courses that have a final grade of 60% or higher. Any grade below will not be transferred. Credits transferred will not affect your UWaterloo GPA.
