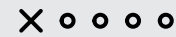
LIVING LEARNING COMMUNITIES

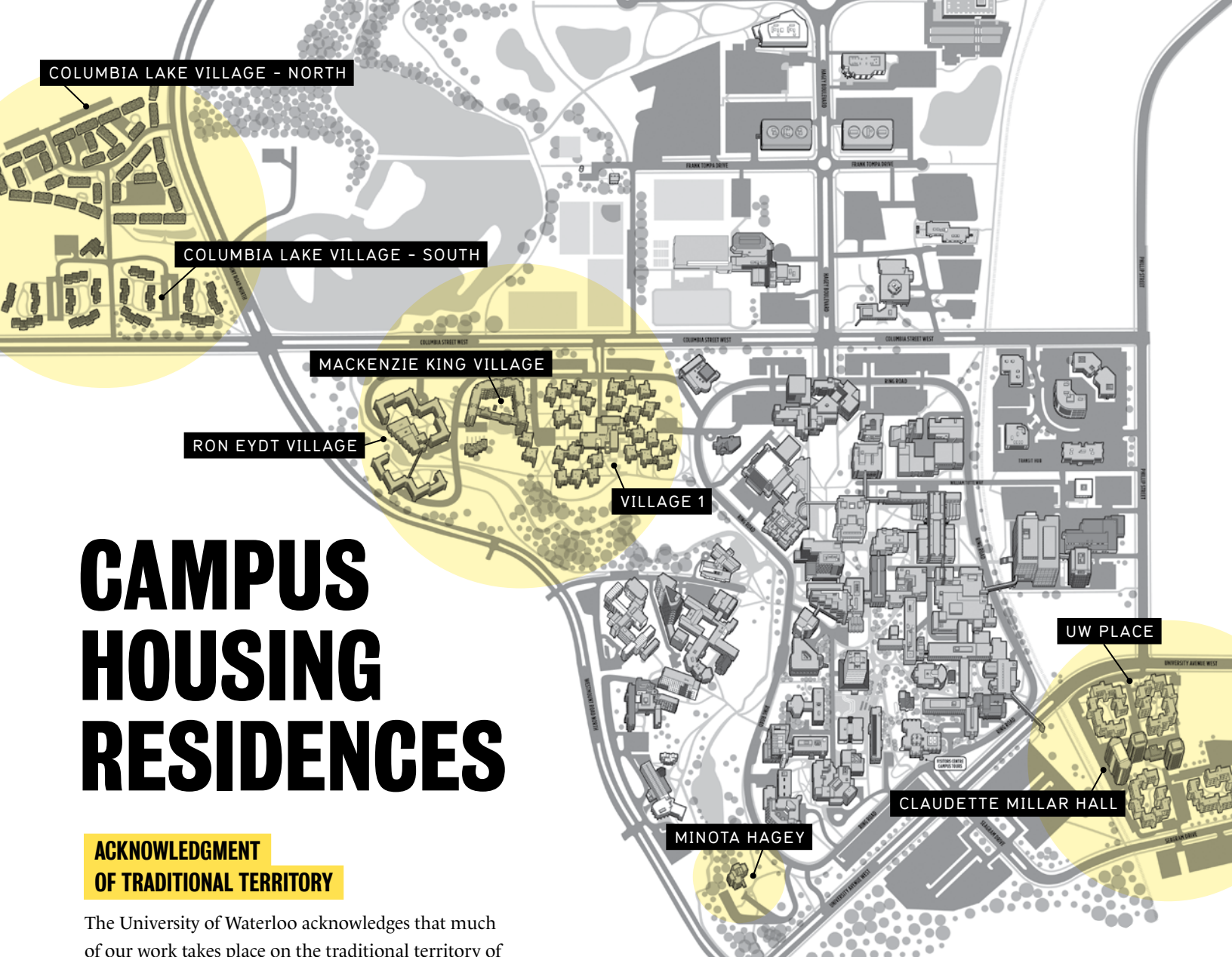
ACCESSIBLE HOUSING
