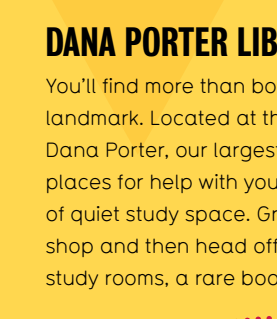
SOUTH CAMPUS HALL (SCH)

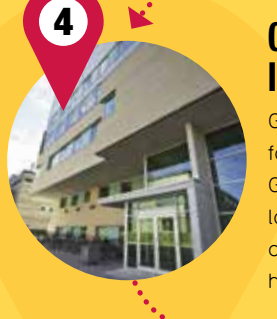
WILLIAM H. TATHAM CENTRE FOR CO-OPERATIVE EDUCATION AND CAREER ACTION (TC)

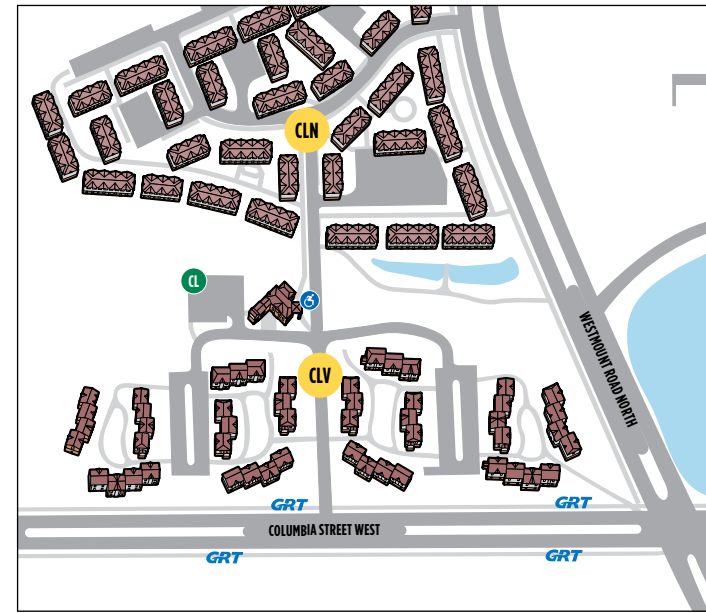
CENTRE FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (EIT)

MIKE & OPHELIA LAZARIDIS QUANTUM-NANO CENTRE (QNC)

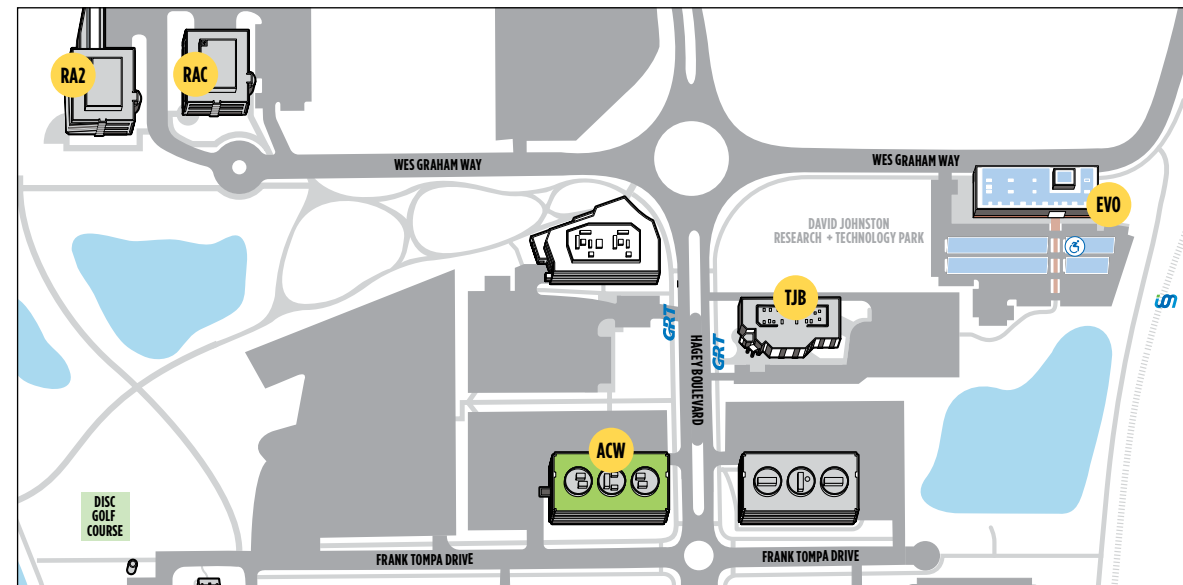

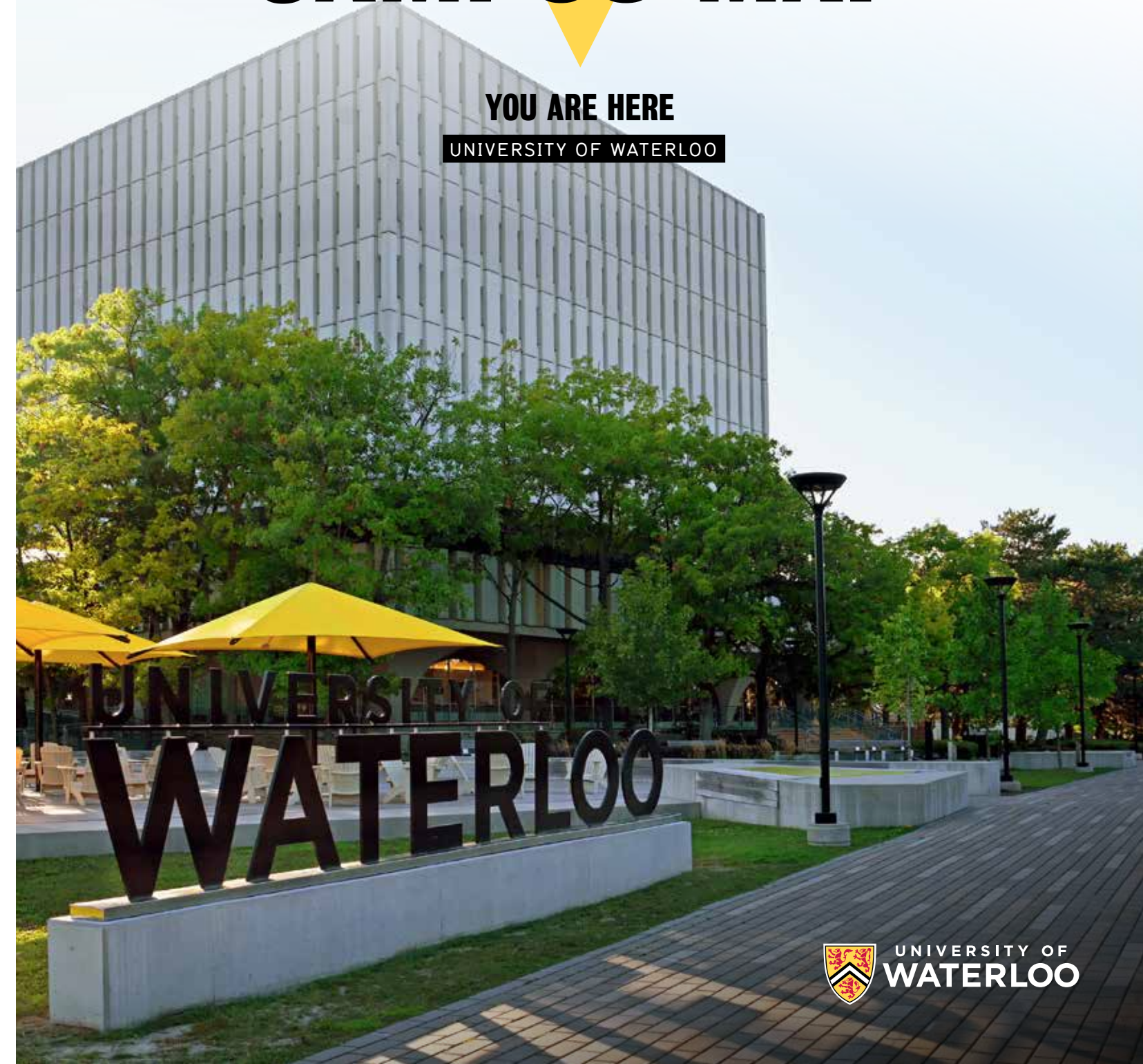
