 - a. Approval of the confidential for the Aug 25, 2017 meeting *deferred*.
 - b. Update on GSA / UWHR Relationship

Full-Time employees are regarded as UW employees and the GSA is obliged to comply with UW policies.

Seasonal (casual) staff are considered internal to the GSA. In this case GSA can abide by its own policies.

UW HR handles all the payroll services for the GSA free of charge.

If the GSA wants to decouple, then it can explore an option similar to the affiliated colleges. The affiliated colleges have independent policies but use the payroll services of HR for a fee.

c. GSA/GSEF Memorandum of Agreement

Motion to adopt the amendments to the draft agreement of the GSA-UW/GSEF. (Robert/Julie) Carried unanimously.

O'Brien abstains due to declaration of conflict as board member of GSEF.

9. New Business

a. Consideration of CASA membership

Notice was given to CASA and they received the notice. If Board and Council both vote yes then the motion to exit will move forward.

Directors discussed the background, budgetary implications, and how to best serve Waterloo members.

Directors perceive CASA too far removed from provincial government's role on PSE and expect more results from focusing on provincial lobbying.

GSA-UW will review external advocacy in general and will clearly articulate what graduate students need.

Information:

- i. Evaluation over two years, to develop an advocacy strategy and an internal/external strategy needs to be developed based on need identified by Council.
- ii. The CASA Graduate Council folded and merged into the Federal Policy Committee. There was no headway made for graduate students yet.
- iii. OGSA has not folded yet it is slowly deflating.

- iv. ThinkGrad an example of alternative network of GSAs.
- v. GSA-UW is going to incur costs that haven't accounted for yet. Until an approach is developed, the money is much better used to support Waterloo graduate students.

The Board of Directors approves of withdrawing from the Canadian Alliance of Student Associations (CASA), this withdrawal will take effect immediately upon the approval of the GSA-UW Council of a similar motion to withdraw from CASA.

(Kearney/Bruce) 10 for: 0 opposed: 0 abstained. Carried.

By April 30th 2020, the GSA-UW will have developed a lobbying strategy and the GSA-UW will have determined wither to resume membership in CASA or to join any other organization with a similar mandate to advocate to government on behalf of graduate students.
