

READ TOGETHER, LEARN TOGETHER

Tips for interactive reading:

Point at different words while reading them, tracing your finger left to right as you go



Point out facial expressions and emotions of the characters



Use different voices for different characters

Demonstrate action words together (i.e., “stomp”, “laugh”, etc.)



Encourage your child as they learn (e.g., “great job!”)

Check out the other side for some questions that you can ask during story time!
