Want to host an HRC Workshop?

Annually, the Heritage Resources Centre offers a series of workshops related to Heritage Planning in Ontario. We host these workshops on weekends in different locations in Ontario to provide better access for volunteers, planners and students across the province. Many of these workshops are hosted by local organizations.

What are the advantages of hosting a workshop?

- Ensures the workshop is held in your community, allowing access for local people
- Opportunity to highlight your community and its heritage resources
- Can provide a stepping stone for further work in the community (e.g. a workshop on Cultural Heritage Landscapes (CHL) in Goderich resulted in the funding of a study on the Harbour as a CHL)
- For every eight people registered for the workshop, one free registration will be given to the host community

Requirements

- Providing a location to host the workshop (space for approximately 30 people, access to a kitchen or kitchenette, internet access)
- Assisting the Centre in locating local catering if required
- Assistance in arranging a local component of the workshop (e.g. arranging a local walking tour, providing background information for a group exercise)

Workshops

- Heritage Planning Workshop (4 days – held over two weekends)
- Heritage Conservation Districts Workshop (2 days)
- Energy & Heritage Buildings Workshop (2 days)
- Architectural Styles Workshop (2 days)
- Cultural Heritage Landscapes Workshop (2 days)
- Telling Stories About Heritage - Using Narrative to Build Public Support (2 days)
