

Master of Taxation – Success Starts at the Top

The University of Waterloo, Master of Taxation (MTax) program is a two-year intensive tax program designed to produce highly competent, technically proficient tax specialists. Students obtain a recognizable Master of Taxation degree.

Accountable & Skills Focused

The advantage of the program over other available forms of tax education is the high level of technical proficiency attainable through rigorous and accountable course work. The courses demand the development of skills in reading and understanding income tax legislation and applying it to practical cases and problems.

Expert Faculty

All of the courses in the MTax program are taught by highly-qualified experienced tax practitioners and University of Waterloo faculty.

Flexible

The program is offered in either full-time or part-time study options. The full-time option is offered in three academic terms and incorporates two four-month work terms.

The part-time option allows students to maintain employment with a current employer while concurrently completing the program. The part-time stream is offered in six academic terms with a course requirement of two courses per term.

Downtown Toronto

The MTax program takes place in downtown Toronto.
