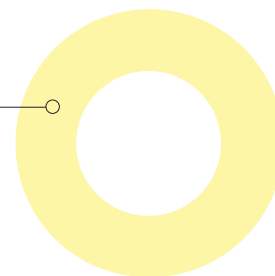


## FALL 2025 CO-OP 100% EMPLOYMENT

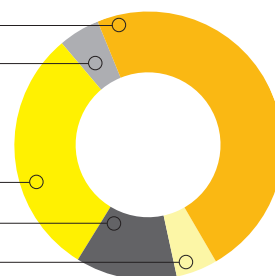
