

Graduating Class of 2023 VALEDICTORIAN NOMINATION FORM

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The nominee must have a Cumulative Average of at least 70%, and an average of at least 75% in each of the nominee's last three full-time terms.
- 2. The nominee must have submitted an "Intent to Graduate" form for Convocation in June 2023.
- 3. The nominee will represent his or her graduating class at convocation; therefore, the graduating class should know the nominee due to her/his participation in Math Faculty activities, etc.
- 4. The nominee must have good public speaking skills.

SUBMISSION INFORMATION

The nominee must include a brief summary of what makes him/her qualified to represent his/her graduating class, such as involvement in student government or clubs and/or participation in Math Faculty or campus-wide activities and initiatives; the summary should include a list of public speaking experience as well.

Note: The completed nomination form and qualification summary must be submitted by **Friday, March 17, 2023, at 5 pm**, in one of the following three ways:
