- Make a plan to evacuate and connect with your family at a safe place
- Keep your children and pets away from floodwaters
- Learn about flood insurance coverage options
- Talk to your municipality about what you can do to protect your home, like disconnecting downspouts from the municipal system, or installing a backwater valve
